Aaron Burr Barlow, son of Aaron and Ann Eliza (Webster) Barlow, Private, Co C 144th NY Infantry, organized at Delhi NY Sep 27 1862, transferred Oct 27 1864 to Co A 1st NY Engineers, mustered out Jul 3 1865 at Hilton Head SC, pension application no. 811606 filed Jul 14 1890, certificate no. 581203, resident DE.

Abager Barlow, enlisted Aug 26 1862 at Utica NY for 3 years, age 43, Private, 26th NY Infantry, organized at Elmira NY May 21 1861, reported deserted.

Abel J. Barlow, enlisted Oct 16 1861 at Deposit NY for 2 years, age 21, Private, Co C 27th NY Infantry, organized at Elmira NY May 21 1861, (also perhaps 62nd NY Infantry), mustered out with company May 31 1863 at Elmira NY, pension application no. 1313947 filed Apr 28 1904, certificate no. 1083821, resident NY.

Abel A. Barlow, or Abel N. Barlow, enlisted Jan 4 1864, age 20, at Marathon NY to serve 3 years, Private, Co C 157th NY Infantry, organized at Hamilton NY Sep 19 1862, promoted to Sergeant (no date), transferred to Co I 54th NY

Infantry on Jun 22 1865, appointed Second Lieutenant Jan 18 1866 Co A 54th NY Infantry, commissioned Second Lieutenant Jan 25 1866 with rank from Jan 18 1866, mustered out with company Apr 14 1866 at Charleston SC, pension application no. 1025241 filed Aug 11 1890, certificate no. 847571, resident AR, widow Nancy A. Burion's pension application no. 791419 filed Sep 17 1903, certificate no. 567448, resident AR.

Abner Barlow, Onondaga MI, enlisted Aug 14 1862, age 27, at Jackson MI for 3 years, Co C 8th MI Infantry, mustered in Aug 14 1862, wounded in action at Wilderness Battle VA May 5-7 1864, discharged at Delaney House DC Jun 1 1865, pension application no. 576427 filed Jun 11 1886, certificate no. 468776, widow Delia's pension application no. 1069269 filed Jul 17 1916, certificate no. 814671, resident Leslie, Ingham County MI [1894 Census].

Barlow's pension application no. 1009317 filed Jun 13 1913, certificate no. 775794, resident MA.

Albert A. Barlow, Private, Captain Watson E. Crandall's Independent Co A, U.S. Reserve Corps, MO Home Guards, also on record of allowances made by the Hawkins Taylor

Alfred Barlow, Wayne Co MI, enlisted Oct 18 1861, age 19, at Detroit MI for 3 years, Co C 14th MI Infantry, mustered in Jan 7 1862, wounded & lost an arm in battle at Jonesboro GA around Sep 1 1864, discharged at Fayetteville NC Mar 14 1865, pension application no. 77392 filed Jul 13 1865, certificate no. 53222, widow Elenor F. Barlow's pension application no. 663585 filed Nov 9 1897, certificate no. 478148, resident CA.

Alfred Barlow, weaver, Lawrence MA, enlisted Sep 15 1862, age 27, Private, Co C 50th MA Infantry, organized at Boxford MA Sep 16 1862, mustered out Aug 24 1863, pension application no. 800530 filed Jul 9

Andrew J. Barlow, Private, Co G 12th IN Infantry (organized May 1861 at Indianapolis IN for 1 year, mustered out May 16 1862),

transferred to Co B 101st IN Infantry (organized Sep 1862 at Wabash IN), promoted to First Lieutenant, died Sep 19 1864, buried Chattanooga TN National Cemetery, mother Sarah Barlow's pension application no. 204793 filed Jul 25 1872, certificate no. 163244.

Barlow: Assistant Surgeon, 4th WV Infantry, reported missing after Feb 28 1863; as Augustus C. Barlow: re-entered service Mar 10 1863 for 3 years, Surgeon, 62th OH Regiment; breveted Lieutenant Colonel Mar 16 1865; discharged Sep 1 1865; widow Blanch E. Barlow's pension application no. 443635 filed Jul 24 1890, certificate no. 316896, resident KS.

Benjamin Barlow, alias Benjamin Haddock, Private, Co G 110th U.S. Colored Infantry, organized Jun 25 1864 from 2nd AL Colored Infantry which was organized Nov 20 1863 at Pulaski TN, mustered out Feb 6 1866, pension application no. 1105462 filed Apr 11 1892, certificate no. 1075986, resident GA, widow Sarah Barlow's pension application no. 1070893 filed Aug 23 1916, certificate no. 919483, resident GA.

Benjamin Barlow, enlisted Jun 26 1861 for 3 years, age 19, Private, Co I 25th OH Infantry, organized at Columbus OH Jun 28 1861, appointed Corporal Apr 1 1864, died Jul 23 or 24 1865 at Beaufort SC of disease, buried at Beaufort SC.

Benjamin Barlow, Detroit MI, enlisted Aug 5 1861, age 35, at Fort Wayne MI for 3 years, Co F 5th MI Infantry, organized at Detroit Aug 28 1861, wounded in action at Gettysburg PA Jul 2 1863, transferred to Veterans Reserve Corps Nov 1 1863, pension application no. 226321 filed Oct 11 1876, certificate no. 156304, died Mar 24 1878 & buried at Hudson NY.

I am currently writing a book on the BARLOW family of Lancashire and Sussex County, England; Isle of Wight County, Virginia; Wake County, North Carolina; Edgefield County, South Carolina; and several counties of Georgia and Alabama. I am interested in any information regarding the BARLOW family of Lancashire and Sussex County, England, with emphasis on the lineage of Edward BARLOW (1560-1620) of Southampton, England. Edward BARLOW was a descendant of the Barlows of Barlow Moor near Manchester and several of his family were prominent clergymen, including William BARLOW (1498-1568) who was appointed Bishop of Chichester in 1559, becoming the first Protestant Bishop of England. Edward BARLOW married Joan RISHTON in 1592 and their children were:

- i. Henry BARLOW was born in 1597 and died at a very early age.
- ii. Abigail BARLOW was born in 1599. She married George PARKER.
- iii. Richard BARLOW was born in 1600. No records found.
- iv. Henry BARLOW was born in 1601. He came to Virginia in 1623.
- v. Ralph BARLOW was born in 1605. He married Katherine WEST.
- vi. Mary BARLOW was born in 1609. No records found.

Any information pertaining to this BARLOW family would be very much appreciated and if my research would be of assistance to other Barlow genealogists I would be glad to share it with them.
