Joseph Barlow of Genesee County, Michigan

Joseph Barlow was born on August 2, 1828, in England and was a son of Robert and Mary (Atkinson) Barlow. He died on September 15, 1911, at Gaines Township, Genesee County, Michigan, and was buried in the Bristol Cemetery at Flint Township in Genesee County.

Joseph Barlow came to this country around 1850 or soon thereafter and settled in Michigan. He and his family were recorded at Mundy Township, Genesee County, Michigan, in the 1860 census and at Gaines Township, Genesee County, Michigan, in the 1870 census.

Joseph Barlow married Margaret Christian, probably in England and probably soon before they left England to come to Michigan. She was born on November 7, 1828, in England and was a daughter of Nathaniel and Garal (Andrews) Christian. She died on June 13, 1905, and was buried in the Bristol Cemetery.

Joseph and Margaret Barlow's children were:

i. Joseph Barlow, Jr., was born in 1853 in Michigan [1860 & 1870 censuses]. He married Viola Darling in 1877 in Genesee County [IGI].

ii. Margaret A. Barlow was born in 1855 in Michigan [1860 & 1870 censuses]. She married John W. Holden on December 4, 1879, in Genesee County [IGI].

iii. Robert N. Barlow was born on April 30, 1856, in Michigan. He died on February 22, 1912, at Mundy Township and was buried in the Bristol Cemetery. He married Emma J. Eisentrager on January 1, 1877, in Genesee County [IGI]. She was born on December 12, 1858, and was a daughter of Louis and Christina (Schumann) Eisentrager. She died on August 28, 1909, and was buried in the Bristol Cemetery. Their child was Ernest H. Barlow

who was born in 1884 at Mundy Township, Genesee County [IGI].

iv. Samuel Barlow was born in March 1860 in Michigan [1860 census]. Andrew Barlow was born in 1861 in Michigan [1870 census]. [It is strongly suspected that Samuel and Andrew are probably the same person]

v. John W. Barlow was born on November 27, 1863, in Michigan. He was

recorded with his parents in the 1870 census. He died on September 8, 1873, at age 9 years 9 months 11 days and was buried in the Swartz Creek Cemetery, Genesee County.

vi. Elmer Barlow was born in 1867 in Michigan [1870 census].

Joseph Barlow of Pennsylvania

Joseph Barlow was born in April 1787 near Manchester, England, and came to the United States around 1819. He died on May 22, 1858, in a fire at his home at Abington, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania (the part of Luzerne County that includes Abington and Scranton became Lackawanna County on August 13, 1878).

Joseph Barlow and his family helped organize the Providence Presbyterian Church at Scranton on October 5, 1846, and he was its pastor from 1846 to 1857. His wife, Phoebe Barlow, was one of seven charter members. It was the first Presbyterian Church in the area and its first building was completed in 1848 on the corner of Church Avenue and Oak Street.

Joseph Barlow married Phoebe Phillips on March 5, 1833, in Hunterdon County, New Jersey [IGI]. She was born in 1808 in New Jersey [1860 federal census]. After Joseph's death, she was recorded living with her daughter Sarah and her husband at Scranton in the 1860 census.

The children of Joseph and Phoebe were:

i. Sarah Barlow was born in 1835 in New Jersey [1860 federal census]. She married William G. Dowd. He was born in 1827 in Connecticut and was recorded as a hardware merchant at Scranton in the 1860 census.

ii. Harriet (Hattie) Phillips Barlow was born in 1837 in Pennsylvania [1860 federal census]. She was a teacher and was recorded with her mother and sisters at Scranton in the 1860 census.

iii. Rosalie Barlow was born in 1839 in Pennsylvania [1860 federal census]. She was a teacher and was recorded as Rose E. Barlow with her mother and sisters at Scranton in the 1860 census.

iv. Ellen Barlow was born in 1841 in Pennsylvania [1860 federal census]. She was a teacher and was recorded with her mother and sisters at Scranton in the 1860 census.

v. Carrie Barlow was born in 1843 in Pennsylvania [1860 federal census]. She was a teacher and was recorded with her mother and sisters at Scranton in the 1860 census.

vi. John R. Barlow was born in 1848 in Pennsylvania [1860 federal census]. He was recorded with his mother and sisters at Scranton in the 1860 census.

John Barlow of Wisconsin and New Jersey

1. **John Barlow** was born about 1833 in England [1860 census] and came to America around 1850. He was recorded as a day laborer with his family at Portage, Columbia County, Wisconsin, in the 1860 census. Sometime between 1860 and 1863, John and his family moved to Trenton, Mercer County, New Jersey.

John Barlow served and died in the Civil War. He enlisted on August 15, 1863, for three years as a Private in Company K of the 35th New Jersey Infantry Regiment. He died on August 4, 1864, of wounds received before Atlanta, Georgia, and was buried in Section J, Grave No. 333, in the Marietta Georgia National Cemetery. His widow Mary Barlow filed pension application no. 69680 on October 22, 1864, and received certificate no. 64367.

John Barlow married Mary J. ---- around 1850. She was born about 1837 in England [1860 census]. Their children were:

2. i. Thomas Barlow was born about 1855 in Wisconsin [1860 census], probably at Portage.

3. ii. Isadore Barlow was born about 1858 in Wisconsin [1860 census], probably at Portage.

4. iii. Charles Barlow was born in 1859-60 at Portage.

5. iv. Jackson Barlow was born around 1862 at Trenton, Mercer County, New Jersey.

2. Thomas Barlow was born about 1855 probably at Portage, Columbia County, Wisconsin [1860 census], and was a son of 1. John and Mary J. Barlow. Nothing further is known about him.

3. Isadore Barlow was born about 1855 probably at Portage, Columbia County, Wisconsin [1860 census], and was a son of 1. John and Mary J. Barlow. Nothing further is known about him.

4. Charles C. Barlow was born in 1859 at Portage, Columbia County, Wisconsin, and was a son of 1. John and Mary J. Barlow [Vermont marriage record]. He moved to New Jersey with his parents and around 1875 he moved to Wilmington, Windham County, Vermont [*History of Wilmington*]. He died in 1950 at Wilmington and was buried there in the Riverview Cemetery.

Charles C. Barlow married Alice Joanna Fox on January 18, 1885, at Wilmington [Vermont vital records]. She was born in 1863 [gravestone] and was a daughter of Moses K. Fox of Wilmington. She died in 1936 at Wilmington and was buried there in the Riverview Cemetery. Their children were:

i. Irene Mabel Barlow was born on April 23, 1886, at Wilmington. She married John Stowe Fowler on January 18, 1908, at Wilmington.

ii. Iona Dolly Barlow was born on March 23, 1888, at Wilmington.

iii. Byron Kilby Barlow, or Hector K. Barlow [gravestone], was born on May 8, 1891, at Wilmington. He died in 1928 at

Wilmington and was buried there in the Riverview Cemetery.

iv. Earl Fox Barlow was born on February 19, 1894, at Wilmington. He died on November 3, 1894, at Wilmington and was buried there in the Riverview Cemetery..

v. Harriet Susan Barlow was born on August 22, 1895, at Wilmington. She died on May 28, 1896, at Wilmington and was buried there in the Riverview Cemetery.

5. Jackson Barlow was born in 1861 at Trenton, Mercer County, New Jersey [gravestone & son Charles' birth record], and was a son of 1. John and Mary J. Barlow. Sometime before 1896 he moved to Wilmington, Windham County, Vermont. He died in 1920 at Wilmington and was buried there in the Riverview Cemetery.

Jackson Barlow married Carrie Stock. She was born in 1861 at Mount Holly, Burlington County, New Jersey [gravestone & son Charles' birth record]. She died in 1944 at Wilmington and was buried there in the Riverview Cemetery. Their children were:

i. Elizabeth Katherine Barlow was born on October 23, 1896, at Wilmington, Vermont [Vermont vital records].

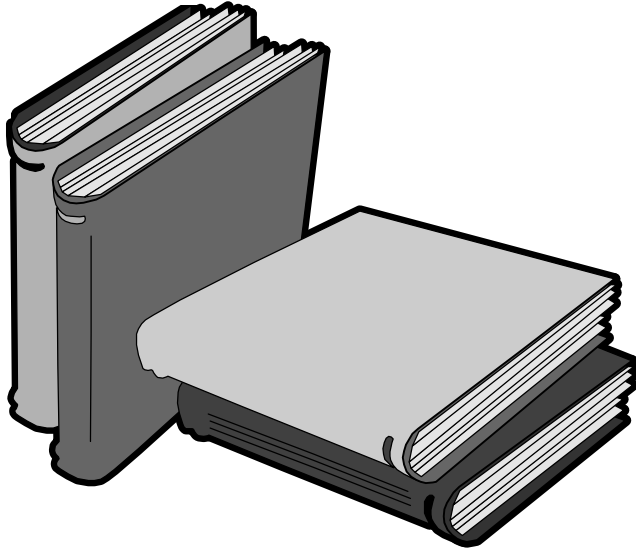
ii. Charles Jackson Barlow was born on March 28, 1899, at Wilmington, Vermont.
