## Samuel Barlow of Connecticut and New York

The following compilation is a "work in progress." It is presented here in the hope that someone will see a connection to their family and contribute more information.

### First Generation

**1. Samuel Barlow** was born on February 14, 1748, at Stratford, Fairfield County, Connecticut. It is believed that he was the Samuel Barlow who was a son of Benajah and Anne Barlow, and hence was a sixth generation descendant of the immigrant John Barlow of Fairfield (Samuel<sup>6</sup>, Benajah<sup>5</sup>, Samuel<sup>4</sup>, John<sup>3</sup>, John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>), although good proof of this connection has not yet been made.

Samuel Barlow was a resident at Huntington, Fairfield County, Connecticut, when he enlisted on July 25, 1775, to fight

in the Revolutionary War. He was a Sergeant in Captain Eli Leavenworth's (10th) Company of Colonel Charles Webb's (7th) Regiment of the Connecticut Line and served as an Artificer. He was discharged on December 21, 1775. He re-enlisted on September 9, 1776, and served three years as a Sergeant and Artificer in Captain Pendleton's Company of Colonel Baldwin's Regiment. He applied for a pension at age 84, application no. S6585, on September 21, 1832, in Cortland County, New York, and received it.

For nearly 20 years after the war Samuel Barlow was a resident at Huntington, Connecticut, where he was recorded in the 1790 census. Sometime around 1795 he moved to Middletown, Delaware County, New York, where he was recorded in

the 1800 and 1810 censuses. The town of Andes was formed in 1819 from a part of Middletown and Samuel was recorded at Andes, Delaware County, New York, in the 1820 census. In the 1830 census, there was a 80-90 year old male living with Charles Barlow at Andes, and it is believed that this was the 82 year old Samuel. He then moved to Virgil in Cortland County, New York, where he lived with his daughter Phidema until his death in 1835. His sons all lived outside of Cortland County and some had left New York State, as of August 29, 1832, according to his pension records.

Samuel Barlow died on March 31, 1835, aged 87 years 1 month 9 days, at Virgil. He was buried in an old cemetery on John Sager's farm on the Virgil-Messengerville Road, where his gravestone carries the inscription: "He's gone. He's gone to worlds of bliss. Where saints and angels meet to realize his Saviour's love. And to worship at His feet."

Samuel Barlow's will was dated July 15, 1826, and was proved on April 9, 1836, in Delaware County, New York. The will named his daughters Mehetabel Lewis, Esther Sands, Anna Bloomer, Grace Burr, Phidema Hogaboom, and Theodatia Cornwall, and mentions James H. Barlow and George S. Barlow with no relationship given. The executor was Charles Barlow.

Samuel Barlow married Ann Hawley, probably in Fairfield County, Connecticut, and probably around 1774-1775. She was born on June 10, 1753, and was the daughter of Daniel Hawley. She died in her 72nd year on July 7, 1824 at Andes [*Delaware Gazette* July 28, 1824]. Their children were:

2. i. John Barlow was born in 1776-1778 in Connecticut [1850 and 1860

censuses], probably at Huntington in Fairfield County.

ii. Esther Barlow was born in 1777 probably at Huntington, Fairfield County, Connecticut. She married George Sands, who was born in 1773 and was a son of George and Jemima (Smith) Sands. Their child was Sarah Sands. George Jr. died on May 15, 1826, and Esther died in 1843. They may have been buried in the Old Cemetery at Hancock, Delaware County, New York. [Malcolm Sands Wilson, *Descendants of James Sands of Block Island*, 1949]

iii. Ann Barlow was born around 1781 probably at Huntington, Fairfield County, Connecticut. She married Isaac Bloomer of Cortlandville, Cortland County, New York, around 1808. He died on August 21, 1865, at age 76 and was buried in the Sager Cemetery at Virgil, New York.

iv. Grace Barlow was born probably around 1785 and probably at Huntington, Fairfield County, Connecticut. She married Daniel H. Burr, of Lapeer, Cortland County, New York. He was born August 2, 1778, at Huntington, Connecticut, and was a son of Jehu and Mary (Hawley) Burr. He came to Andes, Delaware County, New York, with his parents in 1795 and subsequently he and his wife moved to Lapeer. He died on December 5, 1849, at age 71 years 4 months 4 days at Lapeer and was buried in the Pioneer Cemetery at Virgil, Cortland County, New York. His wife Grace may have been buried there also but a stone has not been found. [Charles Burr Todd, *A General History of The Burr Family*, 1891]

3. v. James Harvey Barlow was born in 1788 in Connecticut [1850 census], probably at Huntington, Fairfield County, Connecticut.

4. vi. Lucius Barlow was born in 1791 in Connecticut [1850 census], probably at Huntington, Fairfield County, Connecticut.

vii. Theodatia Barlow was born on August 29, 1793, probably at Huntington, Fairfield County, Connecticut. She married William Cornwall and they lived at Andes, Delaware County, New York.

5. viii. Charles Barlow was born around 1800 probably in Fairfield County, Connecticut.

6. ix. George S. Barlow was born around 1808 probably in Fairfield County, Connecticut [1850 census].

x. Mehitabel Barlow married a Mr. Lewis, possibly Evi Lewis.

xi. Phidema Barlow married a Mr. Hogeboom, possibly either Henry or Nicholas Hogeboom.

### Second Generation

**2. John Barlow**, a son of 1. Samuel and Ann (Hawley) Barlow, was born in 1776-1778 in Connecticut [1850 and 1860 censuses], probably at Huntington in Fairfield County. It is believed that he was the John Barlow, age 74, who was living at Cincinnati, Hamilton County, Ohio, in 1850 with a Hiram and Rebecca Barlow. In the 1860 he was living at age 82 with Benjamin and Susan Ford at Steubenville, Jefferson County, Ohio.

John Barlow married but his wife's

name is not known. She either died or they were separated before the 1850 census. Their children included:

i. Hiram Barlow was born in 1806 in New York [1850 census].

**3. James Harvey Barlow**, a son of 1. Samuel and Ann (Hawley) Barlow, was born in 1788 in Connecticut [1850 census], probably at Huntington, Fairfield County, Connecticut. He was probably the James H. Barlow recorded at Cayuta, Tioga County, New York, in the 1820 census, probably the Harvey Barlow recorded at Veteran, Tioga County, New York, in the 1830 census, probably the James H. Barlow recorded at Veteran, then in Chemung County, New York, in the 1840 census, and probably the J. H. Barlow, age 62, who lived with William and Maria Breese at Elmira, Chemung County, New York, in the 1850 census. He is not found in the 1860 census.

James Harvey Barlow married but his wife's name is not known. Their children included:

i. Cyrus Barlow was born in 1811 [1860 census], in 1815 [1850 census], or in 1816 in Tioga County [1855 census].

ii. William S. Barlow was born in 1817-1818 [1850 and 1860 censuses].

iii. Degrand Barlow was born 1820-1821 in Schuyler County [1850, 1855 and 1860 censuses].

iv. Maria Barlow was born in 1822. She married William R. Breese and they were recorded at Elmira in the 1850 census.

v. James Barlow was born in 1822-1823 in Tompkins County [1855 and 1860 censuses].

vi. Lorenzo Barlow was born on April 11, 1828, in Orange County [1850, 1855 and 1860 censuses].

vii. Mary A. Barlow was born in 1831 and was recorded at Elmira in the 1850 census.

viii. Ruth Barlow was born in 1832 in Chemung County and was recorded at Elmira in the 1850 and 1855 censuses.

**4. Lucius Barlow**, a son of 1. Samuel and Ann (Hawley) Barlow, was born on August 6, 1791, in Connecticut [gravestone, 1850-60 censuses]. He was recorded as a farmer at Charleston, Tioga County, Pennsylvania, in the 1840, 1850 and 1860 censuses. He died on December 31, 1875, at age 84 years 4 months 25 days probably at Charleston and was buried there in the Pioneer Cemetery.

Lucius Barlow married Miriam Woodin around 1820. She was born on November 23, 1800, in New York [gravestone, 1850 census]. She died on November 15, 1859, at age 58 years 11 months 22 days probably at Charleston and was buried there in the Pioneer Cemetery. Their children were:

i. Henry Barlow was born on May 17, 1824, in Pennsylvania [gravestone, 1850 census]. He died on September 5, 1859, at age 35 years 3 months 18 days probably at Charleston and was buried there in the Pioneer Cemetery.

ii. Mary Ann Barlow was born in 1826 in Pennsylvania [1850 census], or born

in 1830-1831 in Pennsylvania [John Gile, *Guile-Gile-Guiles Genealogy*]. She married Rosell Giles Jr. on December 6, 1852, at Charleston, Pennsylvania. He was born in 1829-1830 in Vermont, was a son of Rosell and Sally Giles and died on July 20, 1892 [John Gile, *Guile-Gile-Guiles Genealogy*].

iii. Clark Barlow was born in 1828 in Pennsylvania [1860 census]. He married Mary ----.

iv. Julia Barlow, or Juliette Barlow, was born in 1831 in Pennsylvania [1850 census].

v. Sarah Barlow was born on July 17, 1833, in Pennsylvania [gravestone, 1850 census]. She died on January 19, 1856, at age 22 years 6 months 2 days probably at Charleston and was buried there in the Pioneer Cemetery.

vi. Louisa Barlow, or Lovisa Barlow, was born in 1836 in Pennsylvania [1850 census]. She married Robert Douglas Tipple of Charleston on February 17, 1859, at Charleston [*Tioga Agitator*]. They were married at her father's home by the Rev. J. Jorabson. Robert Douglas Tipple was born in 1836 in New York, was a son of Peter and Sybil (Douglas) Tipple, and died in 1896.

vii. Charles Barlow was born on October 28, 1837, in Pennsylvania [gravestone, 1850 census]. He died on August 24, 1859, at age 21 years 9 months 26 days, probably at Charleston and was buried there in the Pioneer Cemetery.

viii. Caroline L. Barlow was born on March 29, 1841, at Charleston. She was

recorded with her parents in the 1850 and 1860 censuses. She married Dwight F. Stone in April 1862 at Charleston. He was born on July 16, 1837, at Delmar, Tioga County, Pennsylvania, and was a son of Israel and Abigail (Deane) Stone. They lived at Charleston. He died there on December 7, 1877, at age 40 years 4 months 22 days, and she died on September 28, 1895, at Westfield, Tioga County, Pennsylvania. Both were buried in the Pioneer Cemetery at Charleston.

ix. Helen Barlow was born in 1845 in Pennsylvania [1850 and 1860 censuses].

**5. Charles Barlow**, a son of 1. Samuel and Ann (Hawley) Barlow, was born in 1798 [1860 census] probably in Fairfield County, Connecticut. He moved to Andes, Delaware County, New York, with his parents when he was 14, and continued to live there until around 1850. In 1851-55 he lived in Chemung County, New York. He was listed at Horseheads, New York, in the 1855 and 1860 censuses, which gave his occupation as that of master carpenter. He died on December 4, 1887, at Horseheads [Pension records].

Charles Barlow served in the War of 1812 as a private in Captain David S. Denio's Company, Farrington's Regiment of New York Militia. He enlisted on September 8, 1814, and was discharged on December 10, 1814. He received a pension and bounty land for his services.

Charles Barlow rebuilt the Union Hotel at Andes in 1823 and subsequently sold it to Peleg Hilton in 1845. In partnership with James Smith, Charles Barlow leased Lot 55 at Andes on June 15, 1837. This was the land that the Union

Hotel and James Smith's store was located on.

Charles Barlow married first Susan Yaple in 1820. She was the daughter of John Nicholas and Catharine Yaple of Middletown, New York. (John Yaple's will of February 23, 1842, was proved April 3, 1846, and mentioned Eunice wife of Charles Barlow and Susannah deceased wife of Charles Barlow). Their children were:

i. a daughter was born between 1810 and 1820 [1820 census].

ii. a son was born between 1820 and 1825 [1830 and 1840 censuses], probably John H. Barlow, born in 1822 in New York [1860 census] and living with his parents in 1860 when he was listed in the census as a millwright.

iii. a daughter was born between 1825 and 1830 [1830 and 1840 censuses]. Dinae Barlow was born in 1830 in Delaware County [1855 census].

After the death of his first wife Susan, which occurred before 1842 according to her father's will, Charles Barlow married second her sister Eunice Yaple in Delaware County. She was born in 1802-1805 in Delaware County, New York [1855 and 1860 censuses]. Their children were:

iv. Sophia D. Barlow married John H. Satterlee, a son of Theodorus and Hulda C. (McWhorter) Satterlee, in 1858 in the First Presbyterian Church at Binghamton, New York.

v. Charles Barlow was born in 1838 in Delaware County [1855 census] or 1841 in New York [1860 census], and died unmarried in 1867. Born Charles Leal, the son of Robert and Matilda (Barlow) Leal, he was adopted as a baby by Charles and Eunice Barlow, and renamed Charles Barlow. He lived with his parents at Horseheads, New York, in 1860 and was listed in the census as a carriage apprentice.

**6. George S. Barlow**, a son of 1. Samuel and Ann (Hawley) Barlow, was so listed in his father's will. He was born in 1807-8 probably in Fairfield County, Connecticut [1850 census]. He was a farmer and was recorded at Danbury, Connecticut, in the 1850 census. He died on October 15, 1874, at age 67 at Danbury [*Danbury Times*].

George S. Barlow married Dorinda ----, probably around 1830. She was born in 1808 in Connecticut [1850 census]. Their children were:

i. William H. Barlow was born in 1834 in Connecticut and was recorded at Danbury in the 1850 census.

ii. Almira Barlow was born in 1834 in Connecticut and was recorded at Danbury in the 1850 census.

iii. Dorinda H. Barlow was born in 1838 in Connecticut and was recorded at Danbury in the 1850 census. She died on February 11, 1865, at age 27 at Brookfield [*Danbury Times*].

iv. George W. Barlow was born in 1841 in Connecticut and was recorded at Danbury in the 1850 census.

### Third Generation

**Eli A. Barlow** was born on December 4, 1818, in Delaware County, New York, and was a son of either John Barlow or James Harvey Barlow. He was recorded in Chemung County, New York, in the 1850 and 1855 censuses. He died on April 24, 1878, and was buried in the North Cemetery, at St. Charles, Kane County, Illinois.

Eli A. Barlow married Esther Moore. She was born in 1814 in Chemung County, New York [1855 census]. They had ten children:

i. Benajah P. Barlow was born in 1837 in Chemung County. He served in the Civil War in Company D of the 52nd Illinois Infantry Regiment. He died in August 1863 and was buried in the North Cemetery at St. Charles, Kane County, Illinois.

ii. Cyrus Barlow was born in 1838. Cyrus W. Barlow was born on August 20, 1835, at Elmira. He died on August 30, 1851, and was buried in the Newton Cemetery at Veteran, Chemung County, New York.

iii. Sylvania Penn Barlow was born in 1840 in Chemung County. She married first Joel C. Shepardson on September 29, 1861, in Kane County, Illinois. She married second Alva Harrington on February 17, 1863, in Cook County, Illinois.

iv. Hiram G. Barlow was born on November 27, 1841, in Chemung County. He served in the Civil War in Company B of the 156th Illinois Infantry Regiment. He

married Emma A. Damon (or Danson) on January 1, 1867, in Kane County and they had two daughters. He died on March 27, 1870, and was buried in the Garfield Cemetery at Campton, Kane County, Illinois. She married second Marshall Hough on March 1, 1882, in Kane County. She was born on July 17, 1846, died on May 31, 1925, and was buried in the Garfield Cemetery.

v. Dolly F. Barlow was born in 1844 in Chemung County. She married Nelson P. Atwood on August 28, 1862, in Kane County. They settled at Belvidere, Boone County, Illinois, and she died there.

vi. James H. Barlow was born on February 26, 1850, at Elmira, Chemung

County, New York. He married Jane Siglin, a daughter of Jacob Siglin, in DeKalb County, Illinois, on December 25, 1873, and they moved to Dallas County, Iowa, in 1876. They had one daughter, Gertrude Barlow, who married Dr. A. M. Slattern of Des Moines, Iowa.

vii. Anna E. Barlow was born in 1853 in Chemung County. She did not marry.

viii. there was another child but the name is not known.

ix. child died young.

x. child died young.
