Thomas Barlow of Warren County, Pennsylvania

The following information was obtained primarily from the files of the Genesee County Historian at Batavia, New York. It was apparently originally compiled by Helen T. Anderson around 1973 from research of public records and from the Historian's book of Allie Barlow Davidson. Additional information has been added as indicated in brackets.

First Generation

1. **Thomas Barlow** was born at Lancashire, England. He married Anna ----. She died between 1839 and 1844, and he came to America, settling in Warren County, Pennsylvania. He died and was buried on his farm, the "old Dakin place," on State road, Freehold Township, Warren County. His children were (complete birth order is not known):

- 2. i. Jehu Barlow was born in 1807.
- 3. ii. William Barlow.
- 4. iii. David Barlow was born in 1814.

5. iv. Thomas Barlow was born in 1819.

6. v. John Barlow was born in 1820.

7. vi. Richard Barlow was born in 1839.

vii. Rachel Barlow remained in England.

viii. Sarah Barlow. Nothing further is known.

ix. Esther Barlow remained in England.

x. Ann Barlow. Nothing further is known.

Second Generation

2. **Jehu Barlow** was born in 1807 in Lancashire, England. He died on August 24, 1884, at Jamestown, Chautauqua County, New York [ref Chautauqua County Probate, drawer D, administration 6-381, 2-65, 5-119].

Jehu Barlow apparently came to America with his father in 1844 or very soon afterwards. His wife and son did not come with him. He returned to England after about twenty years to find that his wife had thought that he had died and had remarried. He came back to America with his son John.

Jehu Barlow married Mary Ann Dyché in England. She was born at Manchester, England. Their child was:

i. John Barlow was born around 1820 in England. He married Eliza ---- on April 7, 1862, in England. She was born on November 7, 1827, and she remained in England when he came to America with his father. Their children were: Mary Ann Barlow, born September 17, 1863, at Manchester, England, married Joseph Platt on March 24, 1886, at Lander, Pennsylvania, died in November 1940 at Stow, Chautauqua County, New York; Harry Barlow, lived at Jamestown, New York; and Elizabeth Barlow, remained in England, married John Haworth.

Jehu Barlow was living with Betsey C. (Miles) Decker and her four children, Orpha, Roxie, Delos and Sarah, at Busti, Chautauqua County, New York, in 1870. She was born on April 1, 1815 [GR], and was a daughter of Solomon and Betsey (Crane) Miles, and was the widow of Joseph Decker. Jehu and Betsey were listed as married, although Jehu's probate says that he left a widow Ann of Shuttleworth, England, and a son John of Busti. Betsey died on June 26, 1885, and she was buried in the Stillwater Cemetery, Kiantone Township, Chautauqua County, New York.

3. William Barlow. Nothing further is known.

4. David Barlow was born in 1814 [C1850] (1802 [C1860]) in

Lancashire, England. He was a farmer and was recorded at Freehold Township, Warren County, Pennsylvania, in the 1850 census and at Sugar Grove Township in the 1860 census. He died in July 1868 at Sugar Grove.

David Barlow married Rachel Mandeville probably around 1855. She was born in 1812 in Pennsylvania [C1860] and was a daughter of Amasa R. Mandeville of Garland, Pennsylvania. She died on March 4, 1952, at Sugar Grove, Pennsylvania. Their children were:

i. Bertha Barlow was born in 1857 in Pennsylvania [C1860]. She married first Albion Fox on July 31, 1878. He died on March 4, 1915, and she married second Cornelius Branning on April 10, 1924. He died on October 21, 1928. Her children were Ernest Fox, born on June 14, 1879; Wesley V. Fox, born on July 29, 1881; and George E. Fox, born on September 26, 1891.

ii. Francis Vosberg Barlow was born on July 21, 1858, in Pennsylvania [C1860]. He died on June 11, 1937. He married Jesse Smith on May 21, 1884, and their children were: Ina Barlow, born on September 28, 1898, married Julius Eckert; and Bernetta Barlow, born on September 17, 1918, married Robert Cole.

5. Thomas Barlow was born on March 5, 1819, in Lancashire, England. He was a farmer and was recorded at Freehold Township, Warren County, Pennsylvania, in the 1850 census and at Sugar Grove Township in the 1860 census. He died on January 18, 1884, at Sugar Grove and was buried there in the Stillson Hill Cemetery.

Thomas Barlow married Jane Holt around 1845. She was born on March

6, 1826, in England and was a daughter of Peter Holt. She died on May 18, 1904, at age 78 years 2 months 12 days. Their children were:

i. daughter, died in infancy.

ii. Sarah Jane Barlow was born in 1848 in New York [C1850] or in 1850 in Pennsylvania [C1860]. She died in June 1866. She married Francis Gray on February 5, 1866, at Jamestown, New York.

iii. Jobe Barlow was born on May 21, 1852, in Pennsylvania. He was recorded as Squire J. Barlow with his parents in the 1860 census. He died on June 30, 1925. He married Hannah Whitley on April 30, 1873. She was born in 1853 and died in 1945. Both were buried at Turnpike. Their children were: Fred Barlow, born March 22, 1874, married Bertha Saggiser; Gertrude Effie Barlow, born March 5, 1876, at Freehold Township [IGI], married Frederick William Launstein on September 23, 1897, at Kane, McKean County, Pennsylvania [IGI], died May 4, 1935; Jesse Barlow, born July 31, 1879, married Mayme Kelley on January 26, 1907, died June 7, 1930; Sarah M. Barlow, born October 25, 1882, died May 3, 1883; Allie Barlow, born May 19, 1884, married Edwin Davidson on June 30, 1903, died July 14, 1972; Lewis Barlow, born April 7, 1887, married Olive Lawson on August 5, 1914; Eva Barlow, born September 19, 1889, married Claude Stevens on September 19, 1906; Gerald Barlow, born April 11, 1892, married Viola Hackathorn; and Mabel Barlow, born April 30, 1902, at Kane, Pennsylvania, married Harold Chipman on October 27, 1923, died September 10, 1972, at Jamestown, New York.

iv. Abel Barlow was born on December 16, 1854. He died in 1930. He married Adell Hopkins on March 22, 1894. She was born in 1865 and died on July 12, 1938.

Both were buried at Stillson Hill. Their children were: Percy Barlow, born April 23, 1897; Nina Barlow, born August 23, 1898, died September 20, 1899; Ray Barlow, born August 11, 1900, married Anna ----; Floyd Barlow, born October 21, 1902.

6. John Barlow was born on February 29, 1820, in Lancashire, England. He was a farmer and was recorded at Freehold Township, Warren County, Pennsylvania, in the 1860 census. He died on May 8, 1888, at age 68 years 3 months 8 days at Jamestown, Chautauqua County, New York, and was buried at Stillson Hill.

Family tradition says that John Barlow at age 18 walked from Jamestown, New York, to the State road where his brothers were living in 1838. He owned 100 acres of land at Sugar Grove from 1865 until his death. It was held by his son Charles W. Barlow until 1913 and by Orville D. Barlow until 1920.

John Barlow married Sarah Bull. She was born on November 28, 1822, in England and was a daughter of David and Mary (Grey) Bull. She died on July 25, 1892, and was buried at Stillson Hill. Their children were:

i. Charles Wesley Barlow was born on March 27, 1845, in Warren County, Pennsylvania. He died on April 3, 1913, at Sugar Grove, Pennsylvania. He married first Barbara Jane Dennison on December 31, 1868. She was born on February 13, 1847, at Steuben, Oneida County, New York, and was a daughter of James Duane and Mary (Whillans) Dennison. She died on April 5, 1897, at Sugar Grove, Pennsylvania, and was buried there at Stillson Hill. Their children were: Orville D. Barlow, born May 17, 1870, married Eunice Wright on September 26, 1905, died July 14, 1945; James Ernest Barlow,

born April 4, 1872, married Margery Woodburn; Blanche Belle Barlow, born February 7, 1874, married Joseph H. Bowes, died May 17, 1902; Clayton M. Barlow, born July 16, 1878, married Pearl Gunning on February 15, 1899; Robert Oral Barlow, born November 12, 1882, married Dora E. Cecil in 1911; Wesley Charles Barlow, born March 3, 1886, at Sugar Grove, Pennsylvania, married first Vesta Orr Abbott on September 14, 1910, married second Evelyn Hutley in 1942, died June 19, 1964, at Jamestown, New York; Grace Barlow, probably died in infancy. Charles Wesley Barlow married second Katherine Crecroft; she was born in 1861 and died in 1930.

ii. Louvica A. Barlow was born on January 17, 1848. She died on April 6, 1880, at age 32 years 2 months 20 days. She married Henry Nuttall. He was born on August 4, 1844 and died on December 12, 1910. Their children were: Frank Nuttall, born February 22, 1869, married Amy Robinson, died April 1943; Dello Nuttall; Charles Nuttall, married Emma J. Saunders, died May 26, 1927; and Edith Nuttall, married Walter W. Keith, died February 10, 1934.

iii. Charlotte "Lottie" Barlow was born in 1849. She married first a Mr. Dean and their children were Wesley dean and Mae dean. She married second a Mr. Tymball.

iv. Emma Barlow did not marry although she adopted a boy and a girl.

v. Eleanor "Nellie" Barlow married a Mr. Harrigan and their children were Pearl Harrigan and Maude Harrigan.

vi. Cynthia Eva Barlow married William Lincoln and their children were: Claude W. Lincoln, born December 14, 1879, at Kinzua, married Neta McGahen, died

November 10, 1967, at Mayville; and Leonard Lincoln, died 1908.

vii. William Leonard Barlow, or Leonard William Barlow, was born in 1859. He married first Edna L. ---- and their children were Ava Barlow, married Mr. Ramsey; Fay Barlow, married Mr. Rudy; and Lulu Barlow, married Mr. Mitchell. He married second Maude B. Harris, who was born on August 3, 1875, and died on May 4, 1964.

viii. Lily Elizabeth "Lizzie" Barlow, or Elizabeth "Lizzie" S. Barlow, died in June 1941. She married first Frederick M. Gray and their children were: Maude L. Gray, born March 7, 1885, at Sugar Grove, Pennsylvania, married first Waid Orr and second Charles G. Swanson, died May 30, 1973, at Warren, Pennsylvania; Mable E. Gray, married Mr. Carver. She married second Willis G. Price and their children were: a daughter who married Gust C. Magnuson; and W. Gaylord Price.

ix. Anna Barlow married first William Frew and their child was John R. Frew who married Margery Huffman on June 28, 1941. She married second Mr. Scott.

7. Richard Barlow was born on September 9, 1839, in Lancashire, England. He was recorded living with Joseph and Ann Warhurst [looks like Barhurst in the census] next door to his brother John at Freehold Township, Warren County, Pennsylvania, in the 1860 census. Ann Warhurst was his father's sister. He served in the Civil War in Company F of the 151st Pennsylvania Infantry Regiment. He died on December 10, 1913, at Garland, Pennsylvania, and was buried there in the Presbyterian Cemetery.

Richard Barlow married Mary Ann Hillman on September 10, 1865, at

I am currently doing research for a book that I am compiling on my BARLOW family of Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia and Alabama, and I am in need of any information that may exist on the following BARLOW family:

Emmett Virgil BARLOW, son of James and Ellen Jones BARLOW of Butts County, Georgia, was born in 1838 and grew up on the "Barlow Plantation" there near Indian Springs. In 1860 Virgil BARLOW moved to Carroll County, Georgia, where he married Susan C. BURROW. Shortly after his marriage Virgil enlisted in Company B of the 56th Regiment Georgia Infantry and he would see action in the Western theater of the War Between the States. After the war Virgil and Susan lived and raised a family in the Carroll County area. Virgil and Susan BARLOW had the following children:

- i. George V. BARLOW, born 1862, enumerated in 1900 Carroll County Census. No other data known for George.
- ii. Amelia M. BARLOW, born 1866, no data for Amelia.
- iii. Francis E. BARLOW, born 1869, married George W. Parker.
- iv. William Sylvester BARLOW, Born 1871, married Claudia Nichols, was a sawyer in western Georgia and eastern Alabama area.
- v. Nancy L. BARLOW, born 1873, married William S. Leak.
- vi. Mary J. BARLOW, born 1876, married Robert Chapman.
- vii. Arthur W. BARLOW, born 1879, married Genie THOMPSON, no other data for Arthur.

Barlow, enlisted Aug 7 1863 at Yonkers NY for 3 years, age 18, Private, Co K 16th NY Cavalry, organized Jun-Sep 1863 at Plattsburg NY, captured Sep 19 1864 at Kelly's Ford VA, confined Sep 21 1864 at Richmond VA, transferred Sep 24 1864 to Danville VA, reported to the Office of Commissary General of Prisoners at Washington DC Mar 20 1865, discharged May 1 1865, pension application no. 622382 filed Sep 13 1887, certificate no. 570485, resident NY.

Edwin Barlow, resident Colfax, Berrien Co MI [C1894].

Edwin Barlow, enlisted Aug 27 1861, Private, Co F 9th IA Infantry, organized Sep 24 1861 at Dubuque IA, re-enlisted Jan 1 1864, promoted to Corporal, mustered out Jul 18 1865, pension application no. 643999 filed Mar 10 1888, certificate no. 978016, resident CA, widow Anna M. Barlow's pension application no. 1700741 filed Aug 26 1931, certificate no. A-11-23-31, resident IA.

Edwin Barlow, or Edward Barlow, Genesee Co MI, enlisted Jul 31 1861, age 18, at Flint MI for 3 years, Co C 16th MI Infantry "Stockton's Independent Regiment",

organized Jul 1861 at Plymouth and Detroit MI, wounded at Gaine's Mills VA Jun 27 1862, discharged Nov 13 1862 for disability at Warrenton VA, pension application no. 8401 filed Jan 22 1863, certificate no. 10800.

Elbert F. Barlow, Private, Co K 64th NC Infantry CSA, captured at Cumberland Gap on September 9, 1863, enlisted in the Union Army at Louisville KY to avoid prisoner of war camp.

Eli Barlow, enlisted Oct 15 1861 at Potsdam NY for 3 years, age 18, Private, Co F 92nd NY Infantry (organized Jan 1 1862 at Potsdam), discharged Apr 22 1862 with disability, re-enlisted Nov 2 1863 at Watertown NY for 3 years, age 20, Private, Co I 18th NY Cavalry (organized Jul 1863 - Jan 1864 at New York City), mustered out with company May 31 1866 at Victoria TX, pension application no. 564234 filed Mar 2 1886, certificate no. 355583, widow Julia Barlow's pension application no. 774848 filed Dec 15 1902, certificate no. 558693, resident NY.

Eliakim Barlow, LaCrosse Co WI, enlisted Nov 7 1861, Private, Co B

Barlow, Knox, Waldo Co ME, age 29 & single, Private, Co F 4th ME Infantry, organized Jun 15 1861 at Rockland ME, mustered out Jul 19 1864, pension application no. 176278 filed Jun 28 1872, certificate no. 127626, widow Martha Barlow's pension application filed Apr 29 1908, certificate no. 664861, resident Quincy MA [C1890].

Elkanah Barlow, Cooper County Provisional Enrolled MO Militia, Shoemaker's Co, pension application no. 976009 filed Sep 2 1890, resident MO.

Ezra D. Barlow, enlisted Feb 24 1864, age 21, at Allegan MI for 3 years, Co K 3rd MI Cavalry, organized Aug-Nov 1861 at Grand Rapids MI, transferred to Co M Jun 9 1865, mustered out Feb 12 1866 at San Antonio TX, pension application no. 964424 filed Aug 11 1890, certificate no. 820941, resident Heath, Allegan Co MI in 1894 census, widow Margaret Barlow's pension application no. 1180558 filed Oct 20 1921, certificate no. 917117, resident Heath, Allegan County MI [C1894], buried Winchester Cemetery, Kent Co MI.

F. R. Barlow, Private, died Jul 17 1862, buried Cypress Hill Cemetery, Long Island NY.

Fayette W. Barlow, enlisted Sep 19 1864 at Poughkeepsie NY for 1 year, age 18, Private, Co C 159th NY Infantry "2nd Dutchess & Columbia Regiment", organized Nov 1 1862 at New York City, discharged May 9 1865, pension application filed Nov 25 1890, certificate no. 706648, resident NH.

Felix G. Barlow, Private, Co K 3rd DE Infantry, organized Dec 1861 - May 1862 at Camden, mustered out Jun 3 1865.

Ferdinand Barlow, Private, Co G 11th KY Cavalry, organized Sep 26 1862 at Louisville KY, mustered out Jul 17 1865.

Francis R. Barlow, Sergeant, Co H 4th ME Infantry, organized Jun 15 1861 at Rockland ME, died in service, widow Lavinia W. Barlow's pension application no. 38654 filed Nov 16 1863, certificate no. 24688.

Francis Marion Barlow, born Nov 11 1844 in Montgomery Co IN, enlisted on Dec 20 1863 at Plymouth IN, Private, Co E 12th IN Cavalry (127th Volunteers), organized Dec 10 1863 at Kendallville IN, promoted to Corporal, mustered out Nov 18 1865 at Vicksburg MS, pension application no. 506790 filed Feb 25 1884, certificate no. 331855, resident IN, widow Elizabeth (Church) Barlow's pension application no. 1048156 filed Jun 2 1915, certificate no. 793027, resident IN.

Francis H. Barlow, Ottawa Co MI, enlisted May 13 1861, age 35, at Grand Rapids MI for 3 years, Corporal, Co I 3rd MI Infantry, organized Jun 10 1861 at Grand Rapids MI, discharged for disability Oct 11 1861, pension application no. 40611

filed Feb 15 1864, certificate no. 873024, widow Caroline L. Barrow's pension application no. 546637 filed Apr 9 1892, certificate no. 399541, resident MI, minor child Ellen Buchanan's pension application no. 614008 filed May 11 1895, certificate no. 444263, resident MI.

Francis Channing Barlow, NY; Private, Co F Engineers 12th NY State Militia, enlisted Apr 19 1861, served 3 months in 1861; appointed First Lieutenant May 1 1861, mustered out Aug 1 1861; re-entered service Nov 9 1861 as Lieutenant Colonel, 61st NY Infantry "Astor Regiment" "1st Regiment Clinton Guard", organized Nov 21 1861 at New York City; promoted to Colonel Apr 14 1862; promoted to Brigadier General Sep 19 1862; breveted Major General Aug 1 1864 for highly meritorious and distinguished conduct throughout the campaigns and particularly for gallant and good conduct while leading his division in the assault on the enemy's works at Spotsylvania; promotion to Major General confirmed May 25 1865; resigned Nov 16 1865; died Jan 11 1896.

Francis (Frank) M. Barlow, Private, Co C 14th IA Infantry, organized Nov 6 1861 at Davenport IA, mustered out Nov 2 1864 and Aug 8 1865, Co M 7th IA Cavalry, organized Apr-Jul 1863 at Davenport IA, promoted to Corporal, mustered out Jun 22 1866, pension application no. 955218 filed Sep 24 1890, certificate no. 658634, resident TX, widow Jeannette Barlow's pension application no. 5386546 filed Jan 23 1892, certificate no. 345347, resident TX.

Frank Barlow, Elba, Knox Co IL, Private, enlisted Aug 8 1862, Co H 102nd IL Infantry, organized Sep 1 1862 at Knoxville IL, discharged Feb 2 1863 for disability.

Frank Barlow, Private, Co H 17th VT Infantry, organized Jan-Apr

1864 at Brattleboro VT, mustered out Jul 14 1865.

Franklin Barlow, born Oct 14 1844 at Newburyport MA, son of James R. and Emeline Barlow, sailor & shoemaker, Newburyport MA, enlisted Nov 19 1863, age 21, Private, Co H 3rd MA Heavy Artillery, in the defences of Washington DC, discharged for disability Jan 4 1864 at Salem MA, re-enlisted Aug 16 1864, age 21, Private, Co B 29th MA Infantry (organized Dec 13 1861 at Newport News VA from 1st Battalion MA Infantry which was organized Jul 1861 at Fortress Monroe VA from 3 year Companies of 3rd & 4th MA Militia Infantry, mustered out Jul 29 1865) and Co B 35th MA Infantry (organized Aug 1 1862 at Worcester MA, mustered out Jun 9 1865), mustered out May 18 1865.

Frederick Stephen Barlow, entered the U.S. Navy as Third Assistant Engineer on Jun 22 1860, served first on the "Anacesta" in the Chesapeake, next on board the U.S.S. Sumpster on the west coast of Africa until her return to the U.S., next on the steamer "Kanawha" under Farragut, promoted to Second Assistant Engineer on Jul 30 1862, assigned to the steam gun boat "Owasco" the following year as Senior Engineer. When it was decided to attempt the capture of Mobile AL and its defences, an officer of experience being required as Senior Engineer, he volunteered to go on board the monitor "Tecumseh." His services, after being twice declined, were accepted because of the illness of the Senior Engineer of the "Tecumseh," and he went down with that vessel, at his post, when she was sunk by a torpedo during the Naval Battle of Mobile Bay on Aug 5 1864. All on board were lost except the pilots and eight or ten men.

Frederick P. Barlow, Private, Co F 34th IA Infantry, organized Oct 15

1862 at Burlington IA, discharged Mar 31 1863 at St Louis MO for disability, widow Elizabeth F. Barlow's pension application no. 488493 filed Nov 14 1890, certificate no. 449246, resident CO.

Frederick N.
