Jabez Barlow of New York

1. **Jabez Barlow** was born on November 26, 1785, according to his gravestone and in Nova Scotia, Canada, according to the information that he gave to the census-takers in 1850, 1855 and 1860. He apparently came to Stamford, Delaware County, New York, around 1805 because he was recorded there in the 1810 through 1860 censuses. He was a farmer and he owned his farm. He died on April 12, 1865, at Stamford at the age of 79 years 4 months 17 days and was buried in the Town Brook Cemetery, an old cemetery near Town Brook Road and Narrow Notch Road in Stamford.

Jabez Barlow's will was dated November 21, 1864, and was proved on January 4, 1866, in Delaware County. He named his wife Polly, his sons Roswell Barlow, Harry Barlow and John G. Barlow, and his daughters Henrietta Reid, wife of Lewis Reid, and Jane Butler.

Jabez Barlow married Mary (Polly) Edmonds around 1805 probably at Stamford, New York.

She was born in 1787, 1788 or 1790 in New York according to the information given in the 1850, 1855 and 1860 censuses. She died on October 4, 1880, at Stamford and it is believed that she was buried beside her husband. Their children, all probably born at Stamford, were:

i. Edmund Barlow was born in 1807. He died at age 18 on September 5, 1825, at Stamford and was buried there in the Town Brook Cemetery.

2. ii. Roswell Barlow was born in 1809.

iii. Ward Barlow was born in 1810. He died at age 16 on December 13, 1826, at Stamford and was buried there in the Town Brook Cemetery.

iv. Mary Barlow was born in 1815. She died at age 26 on March 21, 1841, at Stamford and was buried there in the Town Brook Cemetery.

3. v. Henry Barlow was born on March 16, 1816 [GR].

vi. Henrietta Barlow was born in 1820. She married Lewis S. Reid (or Reed) on January 16, 1843, at Stamford [Delaware Gazette February 8, 1843]. She died on February 18, 1879, at age 59 at Stamford and was buried there in the Locust Hill Cemetery.

vii. Jane Barlow was born in 1821. She married John Butler of Tioga County, New York, on January 16, 1843, at Stamford [Delaware Gazette February 8, 1843]. She died in 1867.

4. viii. John Griffin Barlow was born in 1827.

Second Generation

2. Roswell Barlow was born in 1809 in New York [C1850-60], probably at Stamford, and was a son of 1. Jabez Barlow and Mary (Polly) Edmonds. He was a farmer at Stamford where he owned 18 acres according to the 1855 census. He was recorded at Stamford in the 1840 through 1860 censuses.

Roswell Barlow married Loranda ----. She was born in 1810 in New York [C1855-60]. Their children, all probably born at Stamford, were:

i. Edmund W. Barlow was born in 1835 [C1855-60]. He was recorded with his parents in the 1850, 1855 and 1860 censuses.

ii. Bruce Barlow was born on January 30, 1837. He died on August 27, 1838, at age 1 year 6 months 27 days at Stamford and was buried there in the Town Brook Cemetery.

iii. Mary H. Barlow was born in 1838 [C1855] or 1839 [C1860]. She was recorded with her parents in the 1850, 1855 and 1860 censuses.

iv. Helen A. Barlow was born in 1844 [C1855-60]. She was recorded with her parents in the 1850, 1855 and 1860 censuses.

v. Sarah J. Barlow was born in 1847 [C1855] or 1848 [C1860]. She was recorded with her parents in the 1850, 1855 and 1860 censuses.

vi. Frances A. Barlow was born in 1851 [C1855-60]. She was recorded with her parents in the 1855 and 1860 censuses.

3. Henry (Harry) Barlow was born on March 16, 1816 [GR], probably at Stamford, New York, and was a son of 1. Jabez Barlow and Mary (Polly) Edmonds. He was a farmer at Stamford and was recorded there in the 1850, 1855 and 1860 censuses. He owned 126 acres according to the 1855 census. He died on June 3, 1881, at age 65 years 3 months at Stamford and was buried there in the Locust Hill Cemetery.

Henry Barlow married Angeline Lyon on January 8, 1845 [Delaware Gazette] probably at Stamford. She was born in 1818 and was a daughter of Levi Lyon of Stamford. She died on September 7, 1906, at age 88 at Stamford and was buried there in the Locust Hill Cemetery. Their children, all probably born at Stamford, were:

i. Jabez H. Barlow was born in 1848 [GR] or 1849 [C1855-60]. He died in 1940 [GR] probably at Stamford and was buried there in the Locust Hill Cemetery. He married Elizabeth (Libbie) H. Taylor on February 25, 1873, at Stamford [Stamford Recorder]. She was born in 1849 [GR]. She died in 1929 [GR] and was buried in the Locust Hill Cemetery. Their children were: Harry Wheeler Barlow who died on July 31, 1872 [?], and Florence May Barlow who died on February 4, 1883, at age

3 years 1 month; both buried in the Locust Hill Cemetery.

ii. Mary E. Barlow was born in 1851 [C1855-60].

iii. Oscar Burgin Barlow was born in 1854 [C1855-60]. He was baptized on June 29, 1883 [CH], as an adult, age about 30. He married Rosalia Bonham Newcomb on December 14, 1876, in the village of Hobart in the town of Stamford [Stamford Recorder]. Their child was Nellie Alida Barlow who was born on July 25, 1880, at Hobart [CH] and was baptized there in St. Peters Episcopal Church on June 24, 1883 [CH].

iv. Orrin B. Barlow was born in 1854 [C1855-60].

v. Roswell L. Barlow was born in 1856 [C1860]. He died on October 31, 1932. He married Mary Ann Barlow on September 24, 1884, at Hobart [CH]. She was born in 1855 and was a daughter of George and Mary Philena (Taylor) Barlow, who were descended from a different Barlow line. She died in 1907 and both were buried in the Locust Hill Cemetery. Their children were: Helen Mary Barlow, who was born on October 20, 1886, at Stamford [CH], baptized on December 9, 1886 [CH], died in 1887, and was buried in the Locust Hill Cemetery; and George Burr Barlow, who was born on September 30, 1885, at Hobart [CH], baptized on April 10, 1886 [CH], died in 1956, and was buried in the Locust Hill Cemetery.

4. John Griffin Barlow was born in 1827 [C1850-55] or in 1828 [C1860] in New York, probably at Stamford, and was a son of 1. Jabez Barlow and Mary (Polly) Edmonds. He was baptized on October 10, 1881, as an adult at the bedside of his daughter Anna who was ill [CH]. He died on March 1, 1886, at age 58, probably at Stamford, and was buried there in the Town Brook Cemetery.

John Griffin Barlow farmed 160 acres at Stamford, according to the 1855 census. He planted 1 acre in wheat, 12 acres in oats, 2 acres in rye, 4 acres in buckwheat, 2 acres in corn and 1 acre in potatoes. He had 2 oxen, 13 milk cows, 3 horses, 2 pigs and 2 sheep.

John Griffin Barlow married Betsey Silliman on September 22, 1852, at the home of her mother Mrs. Ebenezer Silliman at Stamford. Betsey Silliman was born in 1831 in New York [C1855-60], probably at Stamford. She died on October 27, 1892, at age 61 at Stamford and was buried there in the Town Brook Cemetery. Their children, all baptized at St. Peters Episcopal Church at Hobart [CH], were:

i. Roderick H. Barlow was born in 1854 [C1855] or 1853 [C1860], and was baptized on September 3, 1858.

ii. Albert Silliman Barlow was born in 1855 [C1860] and was baptized on September 3, 1858. He married Emily Beers on October 4, 1882. She was born in 1862 and was a daughter of Joshua and Sarah Beers. Their child was Ann Elizabeth Barlow who was baptized on June 7, 1885, at St. Peters Episcopal Church at Hobart [CH].

iii. Anne Silliman Barlow was born in 1858 [C1860] and was baptized on September 3, 1858. She died on October 31, 1881, and was buried in the Town Brook Cemetery at Stamford.

iv. Ida Barlow was born in 1862 and was baptized on July 4, 1862.

v. Fanny Barlow was born on August 6, 1864 [CH], and was baptized on March 1, 1865.

vi. Catharine Barlow was born on November 13, 1870, and was baptized on October 8, 1871.

Pickens Barlow, Private, promoted to Sergeant, wounded and captured at Gettysburg PA Jul 1-3 1863, paroled on April 9, 1865, at Appomattox Court House VA, Co A 22nd NC Infantry, originally organized as the 12th NC Infantry Volunteers at Raleigh, Wake Co NC Jul 11 1861.

Pomemo J. Barlow. Private, Co D 34th MS Infantry.

R. Barlow, Private, Co D 7th AL Cavalry, organized Jul 22 1863, surrendered at Meridian MS May 4 1865.

R. Barlow, Private, Co A 3rd AR Cavalry, organized as the 1st Mounted Volunteers for one year on Jul 24 1861, mustered into Confederate service Jul 29 1861, surrendered Apr 26 1865.

R. W. Barlow, Private, Jeff Davis AL Artillery Battery, organized as a cavalry company at Selma AL May 1861, surrendered at Appomattox Court House VA Apr 9 1865.

Robert Barlow, Private, Co C 14th KY Cavalry.

Robert A. Barlow, Private, promoted to Sergeant, Co B 18th AR Infantry, organized at Devall's Bluff AR on Apr 2 1862, surrendered at Port Hudson LA on Jul 8 1863, paroled later in month, surrendered May 26 1865.

Robert D. Barlow, Private, VA Carolina Light Artillery Battery, Captain Thomas Rowe Thornton, organized in Caroline Co VA Jul 23 1861, surrendered at Appomattox Court House VA Apr 9 1865

Robert G. Barlow, or R. J. Barlow, Private, Williamsburg Junior Guard, promoted to Sergeant, Co C 32nd VA Infantry, organized May

1861, surrendered at Appomattox Court House VA Apr 9 1865.

Robert J. Barlow, or Robert P. Barlow, Private, Co D 14th KY Cavalry.

Robert P. Barlow, 2nd Sergeant, Murphy's Co, Morgan's Independent KY Cavalry, enlisted Jan 1 1863 at Murfreesboro TN.

S. Barlow, Private, Co D 46th VA Infantry, also known as VA 1st Infantry Regiment Wise Legion, organized Aug 8 1861, part of regiment captured and paroled at Roanoke Island NC Feb 8 1862, reorganized May 24 1862, captured portion exchanged in Sep 1862.

Samuel E. Barlow, Private, Captain Croft's Battery GA Light Artillery.

Samuel T. Barlow, Private, 4th KY Cavalry and Co C 2nd (Duke's) KY Cavalry, enlisted Aug 15 1862 at Hartsville TN, widow Mary Harlow Barlow of Barren County KY received a pension Jul 6 1912, application no. 1602.

Simeon Barlow, Private, Captain Jones' Co NC Supporting Force.

Simeon Barlow, Private, Co K 76th NC Infantry, also known as 6th NC Infantry Senior Reserves, organized by consolidating Moss' Infantry Battalion Senior Reserves with other units on Jan 23 1865, surrendered in Orange Co NC Apr 26 1865.

Smith Barlow, Private, Co E 58th NC Infantry, organized in Mitchell Co NC Jul 24 1862.

I am currently writing a book on the BARLOW family of Lancashire and Sussex County, England; Isle of Wight County, Virginia; Wake County, North Carolina; Edgefield County, South Carolina; and several counties of Georgia and Alabama. I am interested in any information regarding the BARLOW family of Lancashire and Sussex County, England, with emphasis on the lineage of Edward BARLOW (1560-1620) of Southampton, England. Edward BARLOW was a descendant of the Barlows of Barlow Moor near Manchester and several of his family were prominent clergymen, including William BARLOW (1498-1568) who was appointed Bishop of Chichester in 1559, becoming the first Protestant Bishop of England. Edward BARLOW married Joan RISHTON in 1592 and their children were:

- i. Henry BARLOW was born in 1597 and died at a very early age.
- ii. Abigail BARLOW was born in 1599. She married George PARKER.
- iii. Richard BARLOW was born in 1600. No records found.
- iv. Henry BARLOW was born in 1601. He came to Virginia in 1623.
- v. Ralph BARLOW was born in 1605. He married Katherine WEST.
- vi. Mary BARLOW was born in 1609. No records found.

Any information pertaining to this BARLOW family would be very much appreciated and if my research would be of assistance to other Barlow genealogists I would be glad to share it with them.

Thomas Barlow, Private, Co K 26th TN Infantry, organized at Camp Lillard, near Knoxville TN Sep 6 1861, surrendered at Fort Donelson Feb 16 1862, paroled at Vicksburg MS in Sep 1862, declared exchanged Nov 10 1862, designated as the 4th TN Infantry Consolidated Apr 9 1865.

Thomas Barlow, Private, Hayne's Co, 1st Chickasaw Infantry.

Thomas B. Barlow, Private, Co F 4th KY Infantry, enlisted Aug 15 1861 at Camp Boone, taken prisoner Jan 2 1863 at Murfreesboro TN, returned and killed on Sep 19-20 1863 at Chickamauga GA.

Thomas B. Barlow, Private, Rankin's Co, 2nd (Smith's) TN Cavalry, organized by increasing the 10th TN Cavalry Battalion to

a regiment in Apr 1862, Colonel E. S. Smith, disbanded in May 1862.

Thomas B. Barlow, Private, Co H 4th (McLemore's) TN Cavalry, originally known as the 3rd TN Cavalry, organized by increasing the 8th TN Cavalry Battalion to a regiment May 26 1862, Colonel William S. McLemore, surrendered in Orange Co NC Apr 26 1865.

Thomas Joel Barlow, Private, Williamsburg Junior Guard, Quartermaster Sergeant, Co C 32nd VA Infantry, organized May 1861, surrendered at Appomattox Court House VA Apr 9 1865.

Thomas L. Barlow, Private, Co C 26th NC Infantry, organized at Crabtree, Wake Co NC Aug 27 1861, surrendered at Appomattox Court House VA Apr 9 1865.

Thomas M. Barlow, Private, Co I 26th NC Infantry, organized at Crabtree, Wake Co NC Aug 27 1861, surrendered at Appomattox Court House VA Apr 9 1865.

Thomas Wade Barlow, b 1846, son of John Harvin and Louisiana Caroline (Davis) Barlow, killed in Civil War.

Tilman Barlow, Private, Co A 36th (Villegigue's) GA Infantry, which became Co A 1st Confederate Infantry GA Volunteers.

W. Barlow, Private, Co C Mallett's Battalion, Camp Holmes NC. Probably Co K 3rd NC Artillery Regiment, Captain Edward Mallet commanding, organized in Craven Co NC in early 1862, became Co C 61st NC Infantry Regiment in Nov 1862, 61st NC

Included in this family history are stories about how a pirate became part of the Barlow family, a Barlow being the first female Federal Trial Judge, of how the early settlers lived during the time our Barlows came to Mississippi, Civil War stories, World War I and II stories, and histories of counties where many Barlows lived. There is information on each of John and Lydia Barlow's known children and their descendents ... names, birth dates, death dates, burial places, etc.

William Barlow, Private, Co G 10th GA Infantry, see also W. B. Barlow.

William Barlow, Private, Co H 1st KY Cavalry and Co D 6th KY Cavalry, enlisted Jun 15 1862 in Marion County TN.

William Barlow, Private, Co E 14th NC Infantry, organized for 12 months as 4th NC Infantry Volunteers at Garysburg, Northampton Co NC Jun 6 1861, redesignated as 14th NC Infantry Nov 14 1861, surrendered at Appomattox Court House VA Apr 9 1865.
