David Barlow of Windsor, Vermont

1. **David Barlow** was born in 1783-4 in Vermont [1850 & 1860 census], probably at Barnard in Windsor County. It is believed that he was a son of Aaron and Priscilla (Andrews) Barlow [see next paragraph] and a fifth generation descendant of George Barlow of Sandwich, Massachusetts (David⁵, Aaron⁴, Joseph³, Moses², George¹). He was a farmer and a shoemaker, and he was recorded at Windsor, Windsor County, Vermont, in the 1810 through 1850 censuses. He was recorded with his son Henry at Shrewsbury, Rutland County, Vermont, in the 1860 census. He died on March 31, 1867, at age 84 and was buried in the Old South Cemetery at Windsor.

David Barlow gave his birthplace as Vermont in both the 1850 census and the 1860 census. Assuming that this was true, and no suggestion or evidence to the contrary has been found, an analysis of the 1790-1800 census data for Vermont shows that a male of David's age was recorded with

Hubbard Barlow of Fairfield, Vermont, and Aaron Barlow of Barnard, Vermont, for both years. Hubbard Barlow has been reported as having only a daughter, so apparently the young man of his household was not a son. Although this circumstantial evidence is weak, it is the only evidence of David's parents that has been found.

David Barlow married first Sarah (Sally) Hatch on April 27, 1804, at Windsor, Vermont [VV = Vermont vital records card file at Montpelier, Vermont]. She was born on April 19, 1784, at Reading, Vermont, and was a daughter of Nathan and Hannah (Marcy) Hatch. She died on July 10, 1840, at age 56 at Windsor [VV] and was buried there in the Old South Cemetery (her gravestone calls her "Sarah").

David and Sarah Barlow's children were born at Windsor, Vermont:

2. i. David Hatch Barlow was born on January 31, 1805 [VV].

ii. Sarah Jane Barlow was born on December 20, 1806 [VV]. She died on December 17, 1883, at age 77 [gravestone] at Sunderland Falls (Procter), Vermont. She married Salmon F. Dutton on April 13, 1831, at Windsor [VV]. He was born on August 12, 1803, at Cavendish, Vermont, and was a son of Salmon and Sarah (Fletcher) Dutton. He died on July 6, 1857, at age 53 years 10 months 24 days. Both were buried in the Mt. Union Cemetery at Cavendish. Their children were: Richard Henry Dutton, Emily Jane Dutton and Salmon Dutton.

iii. Hart Smith Barlow was born on April 5, 1809 [VV], and was named after Deacon Hart Smith of Windsor. He married Sophia Alice Penniman on October 21, 1833, at Brookline, Massachusetts [Brookline vital records]. She was born in 1814 at Brookline and she died on February 15, 1836, at age 21½ at Brookline [Brookline vital records]. They had no children. He was recorded at New Orleans, Louisiana, in the 1850 census and cannot be found in the 1860 census.

iv. Henry Barlow was born on September 29, 1811 [VV]. He died on October 12, 1868, at age 57 at Shrewsbury, Vermont [VV], and was buried in the Laurel Glen Cemetery at Cuttingsville, Vermont. He was a tinsmith. He was recorded at Chester, Vermont, in the 1850 census and at Shrewsbury in the 1860 census. He did not marry.

3. v. Frederick H. Barlow was born on June 10, 1820 [VV].

vi. Lucy Parmer Barlow was born on February 24, 1826 [VV]. She died on June 10, 1891, at age 65 at Cavendish, Vermont, and was buried there in the Mt. Union Cemetery. She did not marry. She was recorded

living with her sister Sarah Jane at Cavendish in the 1850 census and with her sister Almira (Myra) at Cavendish in the 1860 census.

vii. Almira Penniman Barlow was born on June 20, 1827 [VV]. She died on May 7, 1899, at Procter, Vermont. She was recorded with the Bedford family in Bourbon County, Kentucky, in the 1850 census and it is believed that she was a teacher there. She was recorded with her husband at Cavendish in the 1860 census. She married John F. Deane on November 12, 1851, at Cavendish, Vermont [VV]. He was born on June 29, 1814, at Weathersfield, Vermont [gravestone]. He died on April 20, 1884, at Cavendish [gravestone]. Both were buried in the Mt. Union Cemetery at Cavendish.

David Barlow married second Betsey Bradley, a widow, on December 13, 1840, at Windsor, Vermont [VV]. She was born in 1798 in New Hampshire [1860 census]. She had one child by her first marriage:

viii. Sarah Bradley was born in 1836. She was renamed Sarah Barlow and apparently was adopted by David Barlow.

Second Generation

2. David Hatch Barlow was born on January 31, 1805, at Windsor, Vermont [VV], and was a son of 1. David and Sarah (Hatch) Barlow. He was an Unitarian minister and served at the First Unitarian Church of Brooklyn, New York. He was subsequently recorded as a teacher and living in what appears to be a boarding-house at Lumberton, Burlington County, New Jersey, in the 1860 census.

David Hatch Barlow married Almira Cornelia Penniman on May 11, 1830, at Brookline, Norfolk County, Massachusetts [Brookline vital records]. She was born in 1810 at Brookline [1850 & 1860 censuses]. She was recorded at Concord, Middlesex County, Massachusetts, in the 1850 census. In the 1860 census she was recorded as Catharine Barlow and living with her three sons in a boarding-house in the 18th Ward of New York City.

Apparently David Hatch Barlow abandoned his family around 1842-43. On March 29, 1843, Almira wrote to her relative E. P. Clark and asked to borrow \$100 to establish a livelihood to support herself and her children [letter in the Cincinnati, Ohio, Historical Society collection]. An unsubstantiated story has David Hatch Barlow murdered somewhere in Pennsylvania in 1864.

David and Almira Barlow's children were:

i. Edward Emerson Barlow was born on August 5, 1831, at Lynn, Massachusetts [Lynn vital records]. He was a clerk. He was recorded unmarried at Concord, Massachusetts, in the 1850 census and at New York, New York, in the 1860 census.

4. ii. Francis Channing Barlow was born on October 19, 1834, at Brooklyn, New York.

iii. Richard D. Barlow was born in 1838-9 in Massachusetts [1850 & 1860 censuses], probably at Brookline. He was a merchant. He was recorded unmarried at Concord, Massachusetts, in the 1850 census and at New York, New York, in the 1860 census.

3. Frederick H. Barlow was born on June 10, 1820, at Windsor, Vermont [VV], and was a son of 1. David and Sarah (Hatch) Barlow. He was a harnessmaker [1850 census] and was recorded at Cavendish, Vermont, in the 1850 census. He cannot be found in the 1860 census. He apparently died around 1890 because his widow, Emeline C. Barlow, filed application no. 429593 for a pension on July 13, 1890, when she was a resident in Delaware. She was awarded pension certificate no. 286598.

Frederick H. Barlow served in the Civil War. He enlisted on August 22, 1864, at Ludlow, Vermont, and was a Private in Company C (or H) of the 9th Vermont Infantry Regiment which was organized on July 9, 1862, at Brattleboro, Vermont. He was mustered out on June 13, 1865.

Frederick H. Barlow married Emeline Clark on December 2, 1847, at Weathersfield, Vermont [VV]. She was born in 1831 in Vermont [1850 census]. Their child was:

i. Ida Barlow was born on July 23, 1848, probably at Cavendish, Vermont. She died on September 23, 1848, at age 2 months [VV] and was buried in the Mt. Union Cemetery at Cavendish.

Third Generation

4. Francis Channing Barlow was born on October 19, 1834, at Brooklyn, New York, and was a son of 2. David Hatch and Almira Cornelia (Penniman) Barlow. He was recorded with his mother at Concord, Massachusetts, in the 1850 census and as a lawyer at New York City in the 1860 census. He died on January 11, 1896, at New York, New York, and was buried at Brook-

line, Massachusetts. [see also *Barlow of Barlow*, page 123, February 1994]

From *Francis Channing Barlow* by Edwin H. Abbot, *Harvard Graduates Magazine*, June 1896: "Francis Channing Barlow was born in Brooklyn, New York, on October 19, 1834, but was raised in his mother's hometown, Brookline, Massachusetts. Graduated from Harvard in 1855, he went to New York, studied law, was admitted to the bar in 1858, and practiced until the outbreak of the Civil War. Barlow enlisted as a private in the 12th New York, a three-month regiment from which he was mustered out in August. He reentered the army as lieutenant colonel of the 61st New York to commence a meritorious military career. As colonel of the 61st and later as brigadier general of volunteers (September 19, 1862), he served throughout the Peninsular campaign and at Sharpsburg under George B. McClellan, where he was severely wounded.

"After the war Francis Channing Barlow entered politics and was twice elected secretary of the state of New York; served as United States Marshall; was elected state attorney general, in 1871, and initi-

ated the prosecution of the 'Tweed Ring.' After the expiration of his term he practiced law until his death in New York City on January 11, 1896; he was buried in Brookline."

Francis Channing Barlow married first Arabella Wharton Griffith on April 20, 1861. She died on July 27, 1864, at Washington, D.C., and they had no children. He married second Ellen Shaw in 1867. She was born at West Roxbury, Massachusetts, and was a daughter of Francis George Shaw. Their children were:

i. Robert Shaw Barlow was born on July 4, 1869, at New York, New York [International Genealogy Index].

ii. Charles Lowell Barlow was born on October 10, 1871, at New York, New York [International Genealogy Index].

iii. Louisa Shaw Barlow was born on July 27, 1873, at Lenox, Berkshire County, Massachusetts [Lenox vital records]. She married Pierre Jay on November 23, 1897. He was born on May 4, 1870, and was a son of Peter Augustus and Julia (Post) Jay.

Alonzo Daniel Barlow, born 1812 Charleston, S.C., of Huguenot extraction, parents died when he was very young, raised by a milliner according to family story. His name was either anglicized or changed by adoption, no clue which, don't know original name. Alonzo went to Mississippi about 1835, married Ann Eliza Ray, daughter of John Ray and Martha Nobles. Their son, John Early Barlow, married his first cousin, Alice Melissa Ray, daughter of Levi Ray (brother of Ann Eliza Ray) and Mary Araminta Uraline Reeves. John's brother, Alonzo D. Barlow Jr, died at Missionary Ridge in the Civil War, John survived. He and Alice had several children. After Civil War, they went to Indianola, Texas, wiped out in 1875 hurricane, moved to Fort Worth, entered banking business, that did not work out, supplied forts in west Texas by government contract, moved west with the railroad, settled in Sierra Blanca, Hudspeth County, Texas. 2. **Calastus Barlow** was born in February 1842 in Oldham, Lancashire, England, and was a son of Edward and Ann (Buckley) Barlow. He died on March 22, 1911, in Taunton, Bristol County, Massachusetts. He married Mary Hughes on July 11, 1861, in Chadderton Lancashire, England. She was born in 1841 in Whalley, Lancashire. Their children were:

- i. David Barlow was born about 1859 in Birkenhead, England.

3. ii. Edward Barlow was born on March 28, 1863, in Oldham.

Third Generation

3. **Edward Barlow** was born on March 28, 1863, in Oldham, Lancashire, England, and was a son of Calastus and Mary (Hughes) Barlow. He died on January 9, 1930, in Fall River, Bristol County, Massachusetts. He married Catherine Hearth on January 12, 1889, in Fall River. She was born on December 8, 1864, in Over Darwen, Blackburn, England, and she died on February 4, 1906, in Fall River. Their children were born in Fall River:

- i. Calistus Barlow was born in January 1893. He died on January 7, 1912, in Rutland, Worcester County, Massachusetts.

- ii. Alice Ann Barlow was born in March 1985.

- iii. George Stanley Barlow was born on February 19, 1903. He died on November 23, 1993, in Fall River. He married Emma Caroline Mullen on November 16, 1933, in Fall River. She was born on July 5, 1907, and died on October 4, 1997, in Boston, Massachusetts. Their child was Beverly Diane Barlow, who was born on October 16, 1935, in Fall River and married William H. Beardsley on May 30, 1958, in Fall River.
