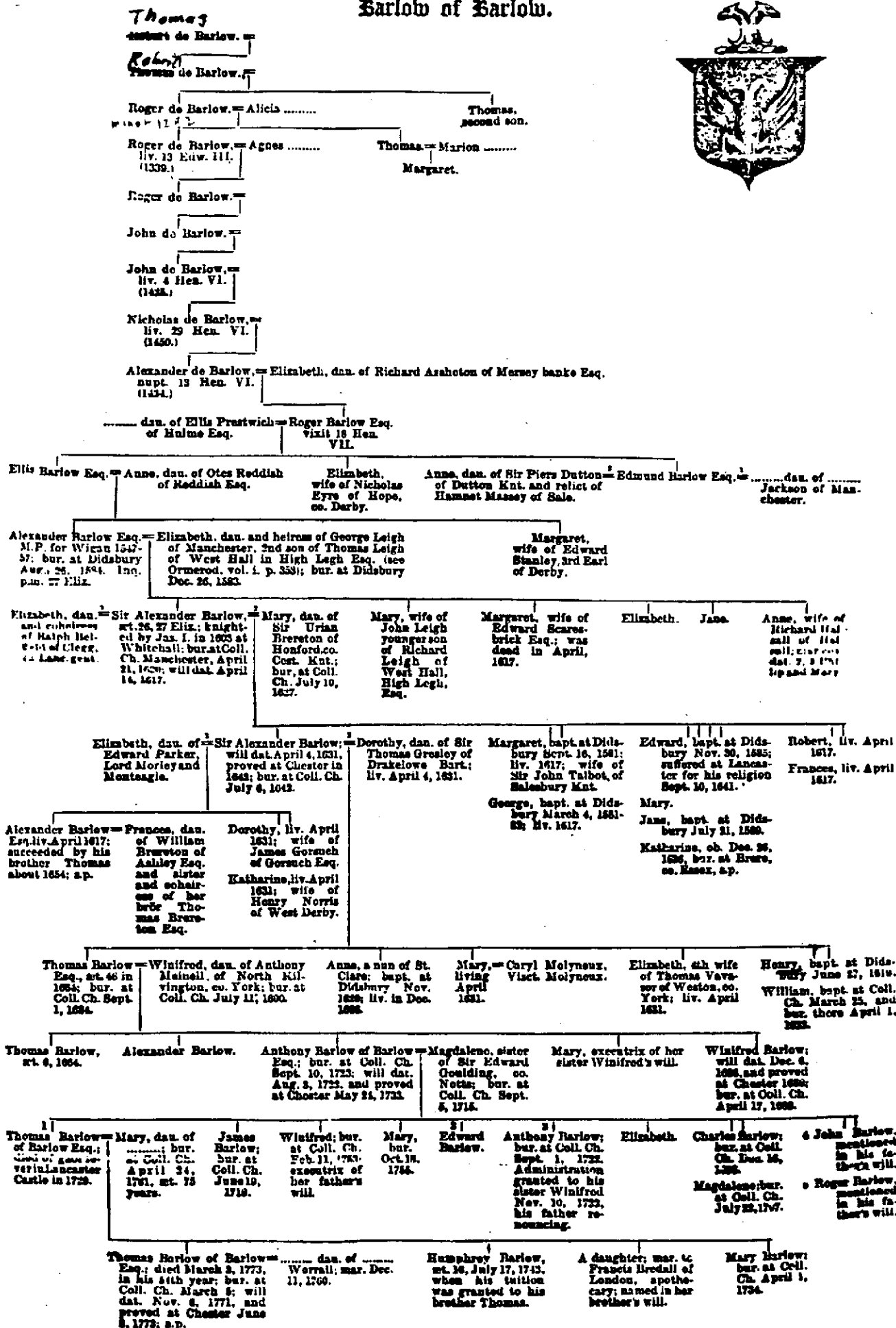

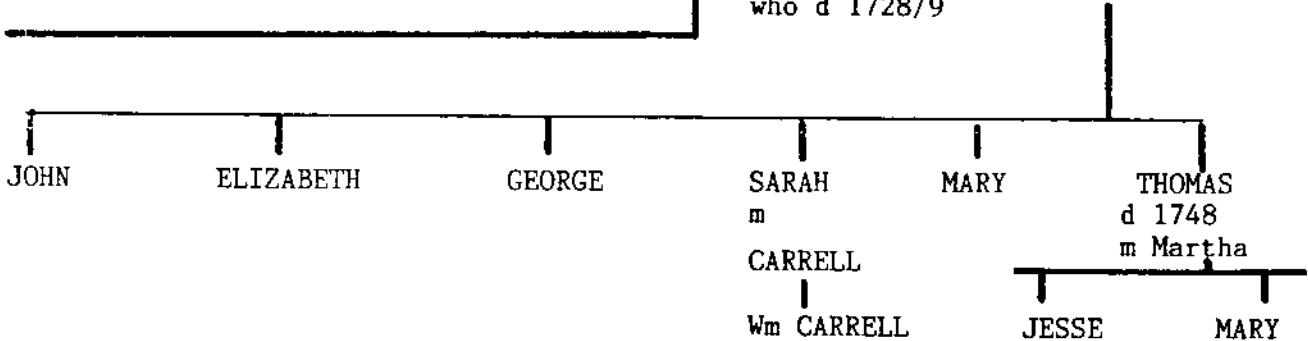

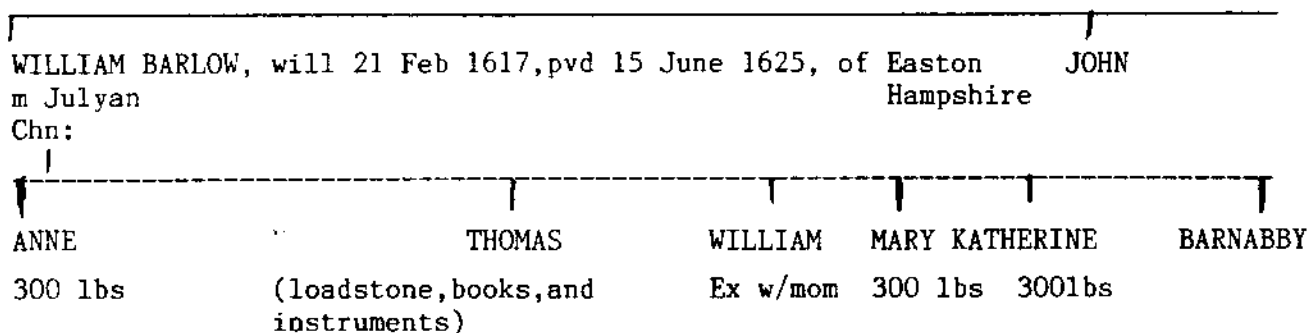

WILLIAM BARLOWE. Will 21 February 1617; proved 15 June 1625. If I die at Easton my body to the Chancell. God having given me ability in my lifetime to provide for my wife and children, I will now be the shorter. My daughter Anne having as yet little of certainty I make her estate 300 pounds. To my brother, John Barlowe 100 marks. To my son Thomas all my loadstones and mathematical books and instruments. To the poor of Winchester 40 shillings To those of the seale 30 shillings. To poor of Easton, 40 shillings, To poor of Avington 20 shillings. To my man servants and maids half a years wages. My wife Julyan Barlowe and my son William Barlowe joynt executors. My son William Barlowe shall have 40 pounds to assist his mother but all things at her direction. My daughters Mary and Katherine portions may amount to 300 pounds each. All such reversions of the church Coppihoulds as I shall have at my death unbargained for and unsold I give to my son Barnaby Barlowe. CLARKE, 67

About the middle of the Seventeenth century, a RALPH BARLOWE lived in Northampton County, Virginia. Various records there show that he was related to Robert Parker of that county, who like WILLIAM BARLOWE, whose will is given above, was a Hampshire man. On 28 Oct 1653, George Parker sued John Elzey, Ex., of Ralph Barlowe and on 28 Oct 1658, Jone Elzey "of Old England" petitioned the Northampton Court that John Elzey, executor of Ralph Barlowe should pay her 500 lbs of tobacco left her in Ralph Barlowe's will.

The surname Barlow was found to have had its beginning in Derbyshire, England. In this section of England there was an area where the wild boar ran over the ground loose. From this "Boarground" came the name of Barlow. The following variations in spelling all belong to this origin — Barley, Barfee, Barlowe, Barloe, and Barlow.

Scattered among the pages of history you will find the name of Barlow. It is definitely true that our ancestors took part in the founding of our great country. We do not have the exact date on which the Barlows came to North Carolina nor the path they traveled to get here. We do know that a John Barlow settled in Wilkes County sometime between 1775 and 1800. He received a grant of land in 1787, but we are not sure that this was his first grant. The first white man came to Wilkes County in 1750, therefore we know that John Barlow came sometime after that year but before his land was recorded. He and his son, John, Jr., received other grants of land in the Beaver Creek and King's Creek section in 1790 and 1791. Eliphalet Barlow also received a grant of land in 1797. From this time until now Barlows have lived in the King's Creek and Beaver Creek area of North Carolina. This is located in the southwestern part of Wilkes County and northwestern part of Caldwell County. John Barlow may have been one member of a large family or he may have been the head of a large family. This John Barlow is recorded in the book, *The Land of Wilkes*, as having been a delegate to the August 28-30, 1790, meeting of the Baptist Churches forming the Yadkin Association in NC. He is later listed as an active member in the association's progress as forerunner of the Baptist State Convention. In 1822 a Thomas Barlow married Sarah Kilby and bought the Abraham Kilby estate on Reddies River in 1829. We assume that the Thomas Barlow owning land in the southwestern Wilkes area was the same Thomas to move to Reddies River. It is only logical that he was related to John Barlow of Beaver Creek. Records were not well kept but we believe that Thomas Barlow was the father of John B. Barlow who married Nancy Kilby in 1842. Thomas Barlow was the only Barlow recorded as owning land on the Reddies River at this time. John B. and his brother Linville were raised on the north fork of the Reddies River. John B. enlisted in the Civil War in 1861. He died December 23, 1862, leaving Nancy Kilby Barlow with a small three year old son, Rudolphus Emanuel, to raise. Linville Barlow was burned to death in a fire that destroyed his home some years later.

Rudolphus Barlow married Nancy Dancy in 1879 and they had ten children. After her death he married Sara Roberts and they had five children.

Rudolphus Emanuel Barlow was the father of the following clan: (1) John A. Barlow married Minnie E. Burke; (2) William A. Barlow married Mary Joines; (3) James Monroe Barlow married Nancy Staley; (4) Joseph H. Barlow married Lillie Surbaugh; (5) Thomas H. Barlow married Dallas Tugman; (6) Luetta Barlow married Mitchell Vannoy; (7) Hester Barlow married Pete Dancy; (8) Elizabeth Barlow married Walter Whittington; (9) Avery Coy Barlow married Alam Goff; (10) Golda Barlow married Crommie Adams; (11) Clate Barlow married Caroline Wilkerson; (12) Vallie Barlow married Jess Dunn; (13) Anna Barlow married Ralph Deitz; (14) Blanche Barlow married (a) Marvin Ball, (b) V.C. Potter; and (15) Howard Barlow married Johnsie Sherrill.
