(9341.) 1. BARLOW. Obed Barlow, born presumably at Sandwich, 1749, married Betsey Hammond and had a brother, Levi who married Rachel Nye of Falmouth, Dec. 28, 1788. His father's name was Jesse, and his grandfather's name was Calvin, the latter living in Maine. Can anyone give me the line back to the immigrant and furnish the names of the wives of Jesse Barlow and Calvin Barlow?

D341. (Old Series.) BARLOW. C. G. C. I. Dec. 7, 1931. In order to clear up some discrepancies in the above query and also supply data obtained after a research of some six years. I wish to submit the following regarding the Cape Cod Barlow family. As there is no published genealogy of this family the following may prove interesting to those of the same line:

George (1) Barlow, the founder of the American branch, came to this country in 1635 and eventually to Sandwich, Mass. He preached in Boston and Plymouth, but the Puritans and the Pilgrims would have none of him as he, too, was trained in the Church of England. At Sandwich he again attempted to preach but was restrained from doing so and practiced law until 1656 when he was appointed Special Constable to keep the Quakers out of Sandwich, Yarmouth and Barnstable. In 1667 he married Jane Besse, widow of Anthony Besse. He died in 1684. His wife died August 6, 1693. George Barlow had several sons, one of whom was Nathan (2) Barlow, who was born 1671, and died Dec. 15, 1744. He married in 1691, Mary

Peleg (3) was Nathan's second son. He was born at Sandwich, Feb. 25, 1692, and

died at Amenia, N. Y., Oct. 1, 1789. He married at Sandwich, July 25, 1717, Elizabeth Perry, daughter of Samuel Perry. She was born at Sandwich, July 15, 1690, and died at Amenia, N. Y., May, 1759. She was a descendant of Richard Warren and Francis Cooke, who came in the Mayflower. (Samuel Perry-Esther Taber; Thomas Taber-Hester Cooke; John Cooke-Sarah Warren). Peleg and Elizabeth Barlow had three sons:

Thomas (4), born at Sandwich, Mass., May 17, 1718. Nathan (4), born at Sandwich, Mass., May, 1726. Moses (4), born at Sandwich, Nov. 25, 1725.

Nathan married Joanna Swift, sister of Judah Swift. Moses married at Sandwich, Nov. 23, 1749, Sarah Wing, born at Sandwich, July 13, 1730; died at Amenia, Nov. 21, 1815; daughter of John and Mary (Knowles) Wing. Moses died at Amenia, March 18, 1799. Nathan was a Revolutionary soldier. Thomas Barlow married Mehitable Wing at Sandwich, Feb. 14, 1744, and had nine children: Sarah (5), Mary, Elizabeth, Mehitable, Levi, Jesse, Obed, Nathan, and Moses. Of these sons it is known that Levi, Jesse, Obed and Moses saw service in the Revolution.

Levi (5) Barlow, oldest son of Thomas and Mehitable, was born at Sandwich, Mass., Nov. 12, 1747. He married Dec. 29, 1768, at Falmouth, Mass., Rachel Nye, who was born May 29, 1752, at Falmouth, Mass. It is known that they had three sons, perhaps other children. The known children were: Anson (6) Barlow, born Falmouth, March 6, 1773. Solomon Nye Earlow, born Mass., 1780. Lewis, born 1787, died Newport, R. I., Sept. 26, 1871. Anson Barlow married Betsey —, and had nine children: Nathan (7), Elisha, Annie, Matilda, Lydia, Samuel, Levi, Thomas, Warren.

Solomon Nye Barlow married his first

cousin Anna Barlow, daughter of (6) Obed Barlow and Elizabeth Barlow and had five children: Levi Lincoln (7), Solomon Nye, Jr., Louisa Nye, Sophronia, Obed.

Levi Lincoln (7) Barlow, born Dec. 25, 1803, at Kennebec, Me., married Sarah Lumbert in 1822. He died Sept. 21, 1853, at Wallingford, Conn. He had six children: Emeline (8), Lewis Nye, Charles Bennett, Levi Thomas, Henry Francis, Sarah Lavina. Lewis Nye Barlow married Bathsheba Howard and had (9) Emeline, Charles, Howard, Alfred. Henry Francis married Alice Ward and had (9) Hattie Frances, John Ward, Grace May, Solomon Nye Barlow, Jr., married Susan Lucinda White.

Sophronia married a Mr. Little. Louisa Nye Barlow, born April 16, 1819, married John Warren Godfrey, son of Josiah Godfrey and Polly Wing. Their children were: John Albert, Mary Ann, Abbie and Alfred. C. G. C. I.

Reverend JOHN BARLOW b about 1740's in Albemarle County, Virginia. He came to Wilkes County, N.C. about 1778 perhaps after birth of all his six children. The name of his first wife and mother of his children is believed to be Mary, but maiden name is unknown. He was still living in Wilkes County in 1820 census, when he would have been about 75. On 29 March 1845 in Wilkes County, John Carlton (son-in-law) made a deposition which states in part "After the Rev. Mr. Barlow left this country the papers and records belonging to his church (Beaver Creek) came into my hands...." He evidently died in 1820's but place of death and burial is unknown. His six children, according to various researchers, were:

Additional Information:

Thomas Barlow and family came to White County, IL in 1818 and are in the 1818 Census there. They returned to Memphis, TN and Thomas was in the 1820 Census of Shelby Co. TN. Elizabeth came to Montgomery Co. IL with her four sons in 1825 and is in the 1830 Census. More than likely Thomas Barlow came from Pennsylvania and went to North Carolina. Found in the 1790 Census of Philadelphia Co. PA Thomas Barlow, a merchant with 14 in family. Also found in 1790 Census of Wilmington District, New Hanover Co. VA a Thomas Barlow with 3 white and 2 black in family. The 1790 Census of Hillsborough District, Wake Co. NC shows a Thomas Barlow with 5 white and 1 black in family. The 1790 Census of Isle of Wright Co, -- shows a Thomas Barlow as only family member. Thomas was affiliated with the Presbyterian Church.

EXCERPTED:

It was so nice to return from a week of research in Salt Lake and find a prompt reply from a COUSIN!

I had not known that Ruth had a brother, had only found, possibly, a sister mentioned in "The Heritage of Iredell County 1980", biography 130, atates "Jacob Crouch-----married Mary Barlow, born November 17, 1772, also in Virginia. Mary was the daughter of John Barlow, a Baptist minister."

Last fall we drove to NH, stopping for several days in KY and IN to research. We found Volga, a tiny little community west of Madison, Jefferson, IN. We found the Hopewell cemetery, well cared-for, and many graves of my ancestors including Ruth Barlow Wallace, reputedly the first person buried there. Directly across the Ohio River, in Carroll county, KY, we found many land records and some wills of the Wallace and Giltner families. Also, the Giltner family cemetery, hidden away like a small wooded island in the middle of a sand company! I do hope KY has a law protecting old cemeteries! We did not find the grave of John (1st gen.) but his will was probated in Gallatin county before Carroll county was formed. One deed indicated he bought property in Milton, possibly to retire?, in 1821. It described the streets that bounded the property so we went to Milton to look for it. A VERY small town---larger than Volga but still small----and not one street sign! I inquired at the post office and they didn't know of any street names except maybe the one they were on was Ferry! A bridge across the Ohio goes from Milton to Madison.
