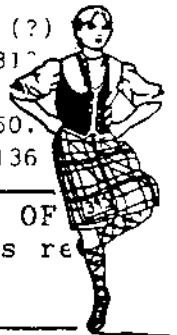

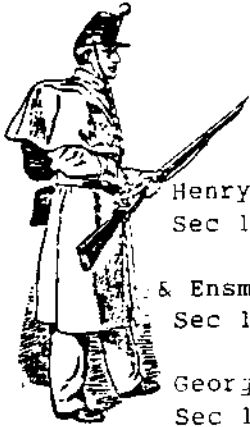

(6) BARLOW-WILMARTH. Ebenezer Barlow married Orissa Wilmarth and died before 1820 as she is listed as head of a family in the census of that year. Wanted, the date of his death.

(7) BARLOW-(-) It has been stated there was a seventh brother, Gershom; did he die before 1800 leaving a widow Eleanor? There was an Eleanor Barlow listed as head of a family in 1800, Fairfield Vt.

(8) BARLOW. Wanted, children of any of the above Barlows, they may have lived in Fairfield, Conn before going to Vermont. G. K. D.

He married Dec. 29, 1768, at Falmouth, Mass., Rachel Nye, who was born May 29, 1752, at Falmouth, Mass. It is known that they had three sons, perhaps other children. The known children were: Anson (6) Barlow, born Falmouth, March 6, 1773. Solomon Nye Barlow, born Mass., 1780. Lewis, born 1787, died New Hart, R. I., Sept. 26, 1871. Anson Barlow married Betsey, and had three children: Nathan (7) Elisha, Matilda, Lydia, Samuel, Levi, Thomas, Warren.

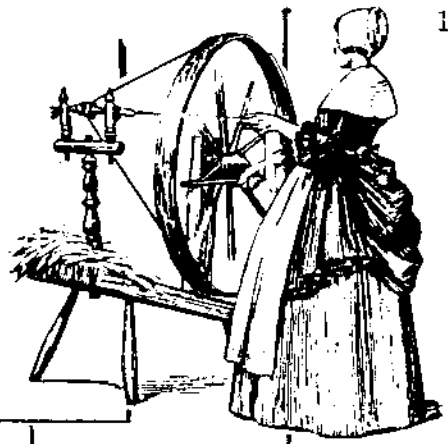
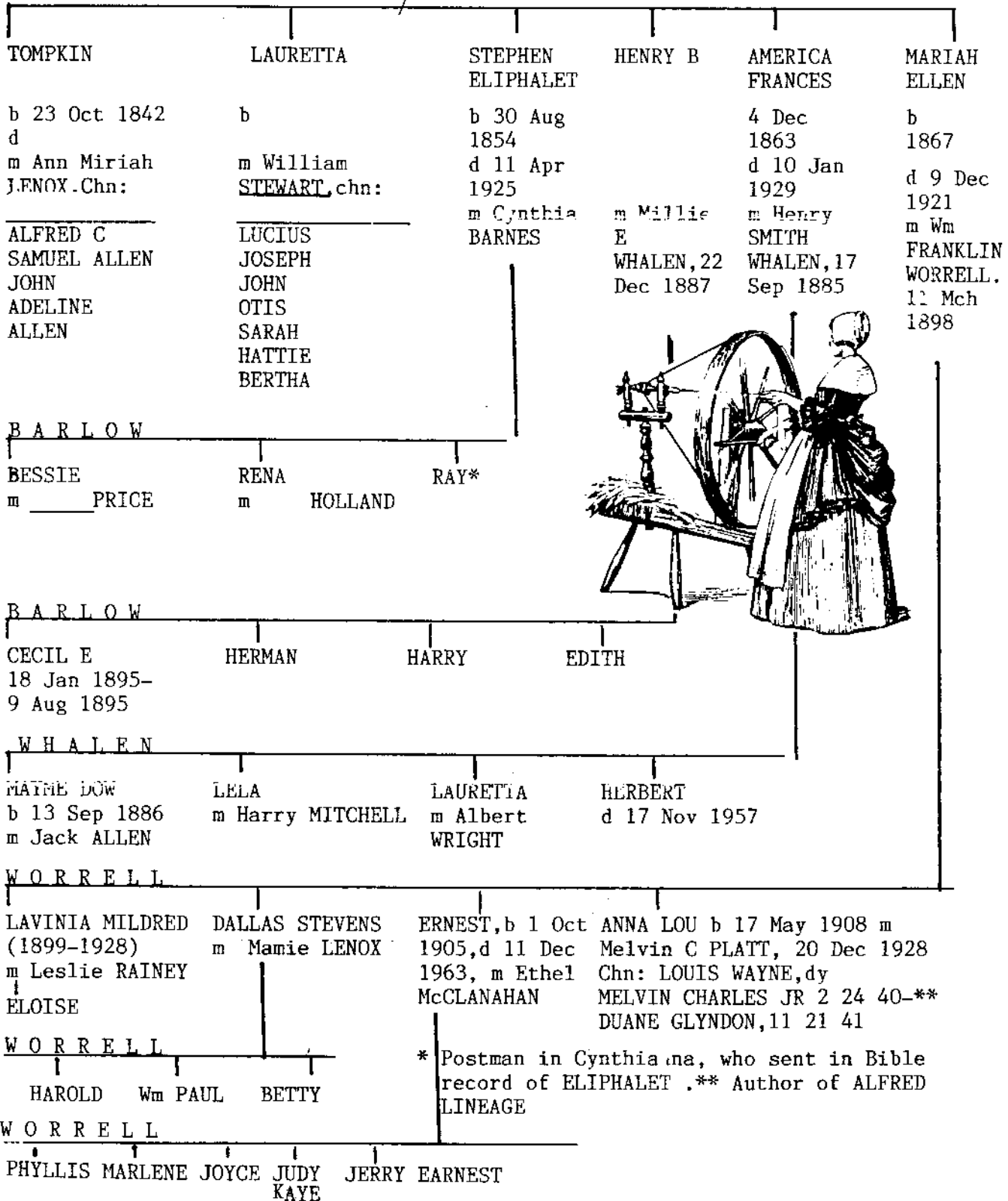

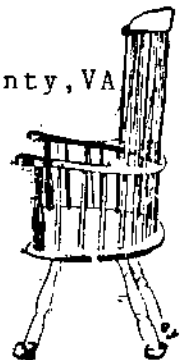

THE PARLUR/BARLOW FAMILY as submitted by Star W Rowland, Sommerset Apt 220, 22355 Province Village Drive, Sterling, VA 22170:

"Although there are many problems and puzzles in tracing any LINE back to the immigrant ancestor one puzzle is solved in the case of the PARLUR/BARLOW family of early Culpeper County, Virginia.: This BARLOW LINE IS NOT RELATED to any of the English Barlow Families.

CHRISTOPHER BARLOW /PARLUR and his wife, PARVERA (probably Barbara) came to Spotsylvania County, Virginia in 1717, passengers in a ship load of Germans bound for William Penn's new colony of Pennsylvania. The ship was blown off its course by storms and landed in Virginia instead.

In 1725/or 1726, working as an indentured servant, earning their freedom, and obtaining land grants, the group moved westward to what is now Madison, Virginia, where they worked as farmers on both sides of the Robinson River, in the foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains. At that time the area was Orange County, later (after county divisions) in Culpeper County and the deed books of both counties contain many references to the group of Germans. They were devout Lutherans, and built a log church soon after their move. In 1740, they were able to build their permanent church, Hebron Church. Many of the original records have been preserved, providing valuable information about early families.

CHRISTOPHER Parlur's deed was for 400 acres, jointly with Mathias Smith. Through a clerical error the deed was made out to Mathias Smith and 'Mathias' BELLER, Spotsylvania Deed Book 12 p 480. CHRISTOPHER must have died by 1747, when his land passed to his oldest son, JACOB.

Some researchers have believed that Christopher Parlur, the immigrant, had an oldest son, MATHIAS, who was first to inherit and died as a young man, leaving no children.

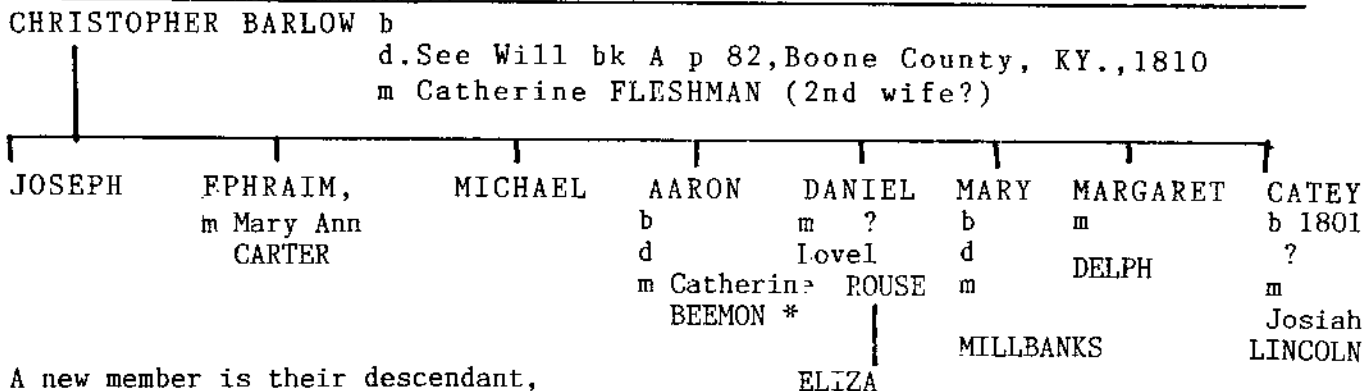
However, JACOB received the BELLER/BARLER share of the land grant directly from Mathias Smith and not as an inheritance from a hypothetical brother, Mathias (See Culpeper County Deed Book A, p 51)...some changes such as PARLUR, BARLER, BARLOR and BARLOW...all appear in various deed books by the early 1800s...

The three known descendants, or children of Christopher were: JACOB, CHRISTOPHER JR and ADAM.. JACOB and his wife, Mary, had children-Lewis, Christopher, Henry and possibly, John. This family lived in Culpeper and Rockingham Counties, Virginia and to Washington County, Kentucky.

Jacob's brother, CHRISTOPHER JR and his wife, Catherine FLESHMAN, had children-Joseph, Ephraim, Michael, Aaron, Daniel, Mary and Margaret. Most of these children moved to Kentucky, but Christopher Jr and Catherine remained in Virginia.

The third son, ADAM, married Maria SMITH and they lived in Culpeper County, though most of their children went to Kentucky. Our list of their children (Possibly incomplete) includes, Rachel, Jemima, Joshua, Ambrose, Ann, Aaron and Enoch.

Our line (Ralph Rowland's) is; Christopher, Jacob., Lewis, his daughter, Sarah and her husband, Benjamin WHEELER.
