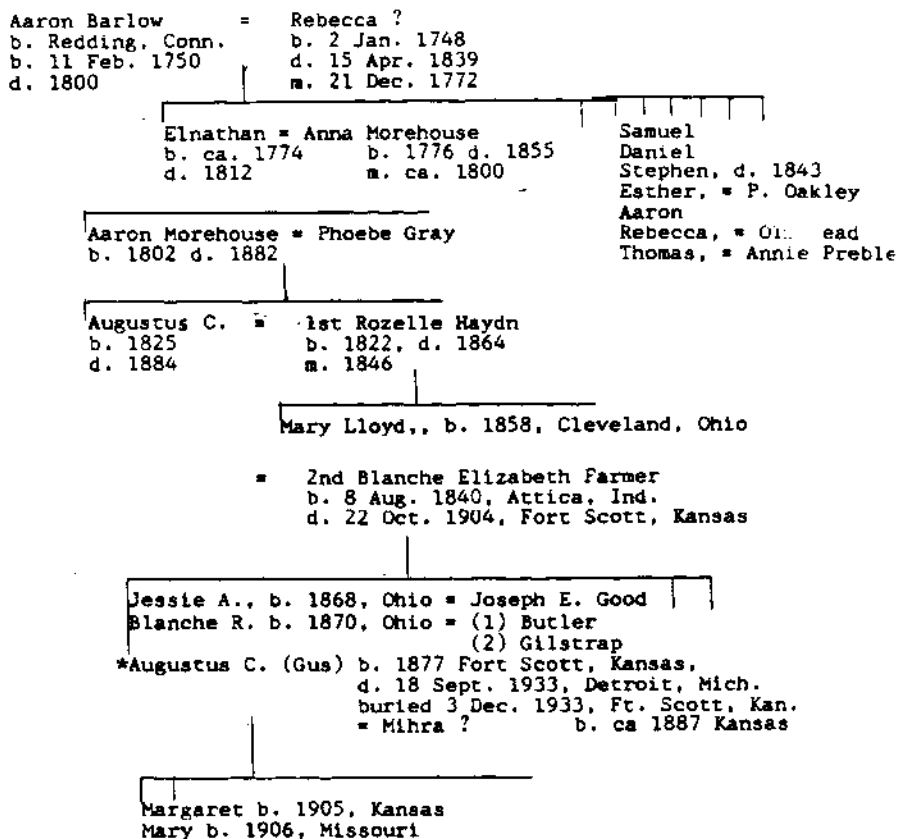

I am nearing the completion of a project which may interest your readers: the complete transcription of all Barlows from all available U.S. census records 1790-1850. This compilation has been most useful to me at times in tracking down various Barlows. I would be pleased to furnish xerox copies of any or all of these records for cost and postage. The complete compilation is about 370 pages; it would cost about \$37.00 to copy and about \$4.00 to mail.

Another completed project is a listing of all the known Barlow immigrants from 1620 through 1850. This list is primarily drawn from Philby with additions and cross references from the 1850 census and other sources. This list is only about 15 pages and I would be glad to send it to anyone for just a S.A.S.E. with 52 cents postage.

My work on the Barlows of New England and New York continues as time permits, and I always enjoy hearing from anyone who wants to exchange or share information on these lines.



* Augustus C. (Gus) Barlow was divorced from Mihra. I don't know when or where. He died in Detroit, Mich. was cremated and buried the second time in Fort Scott, Kansas the 3rd of December, 1933. I am trying to locate his two daughters, Margaret and Mary (above) or their descendants. Also, would like to know the maiden name of his wife, Mihra.

BARLOW, Bradley, a Representative from Vermont; born in Fairfield, Franklin County, Vt., May 12, 1814; attended the common schools; engaged in mercantile pursuits in Philadelphia until 1858, when he moved to St. Albans, Vt.; delegate to the State constitutional conventions in 1843, 1850, and 1857, acting as assistant secretary in 1843; member of the State house of representatives in 1845, 1850-1852, 1864, and 1865; engaged in banking and in the railroad business 1860-1883; chairman of the school committee in St. Albans; president of the village corporation and treasurer of Franklin County 1860-1867; served in the State senate 1866-1868; elected as a Greenbacker to the Forty-sixth Congress (March 4, 1879-March 3, 1881); was not a candidate for renomination in 1880; died in Denver, Colo., on November 6, 1889; interment in Greenwood Cemetery, St. Albans, Vt.

BARLOW, Charles Averill, a Representative from California born in Cleveland, Ohio, March 17, 1858; attended the common schools; engaged in agricultural and commercial pursuits; moved to Ventura, Calif., in 1875 and to San Luis Obispo County in 1889, engaging in wheat farming; member of the State assembly in 1892 and 1893; chairman of the People's Party State convention in 1896; elected as a Populist to the Fifty-fifth Congress (March 4, 1897-March 3, 1899); was not a candidate for renomination; moved to Kern County in 1901 and engaged in mining, fruit growing, and the production of oil; delegate to the Democratic National Conventions in 1912 and 1920; died in Bakersfield, Calif., on October 3, 1927; interment in Union Cemetery.

BARLOW, Stephen, a Representative from Pennsylvania; born in Redding, Fairfield County, Conn., June 13, 1779; attended the common schools and Yale College; moved to Meadville, Pa., in 1816; studied law; was admitted to the bar and commenced practice in Meadville, Crawford County, Pa.; elected to the Twentieth Congress (March 4, 1827-March 3, 1829); unsuccessful candidate for reelection in 1828 to the Twenty-first Congress; resumed the practice of his profession; served in the State house of representatives 1829-1831; appointed as an associate judge of Crawford County in January 1831 and served until his death in Meadville, Pa., August 24, 1845; interment in Greendale Cemetery.

On August 10, 1990 I sent my 10.00 dollars to you for my subscription to the Barlow of Barlow. I am anxiously awaiting the next issue of the paper. It has been so very helpful in my search but now I find it necessary to send in a query to aid in my research. I have the death certificate of Stephen C. Barlow who is my great great grandfather. It lists his birth date as 15 Jan 1842. His parents as Lewis Barlow and Ruth Bishop and his birthplace as Indiana. Stephen is well documented from civil war papers, biographical books in Nebraska, Fed. Census, and certificate of death. Lewis is found in the Federal Census of 1850 with wife Ruth and my Stephen in the household. Lewis is listed as 50 years old and Ruth is listed as 27 years old. Stephen in a Biographic piece states that his parents were born in Kentucky and moved to Indiana with their respective parents. They grew up on farms in Shelby Co. and married and lived on a farm until they migrated to Iowa ca. 1847. Lewis is buried in Rising Sun, Iowa. QUESTION: WHO ARE THE PARENTS OF LEWIS BARLOW? My g.g.grandmother was Matilda Almira Barlow who, according to her son's
death certificate, was born in Maine. She married Leonard Robertson and
they had children including William, b 23 Sep. 1871, Idella, Bessie, Libbie,
and Charles. This information came from their son William, but I have not
located them on census reports. I do not know where they resided, and
William was unsure of his place of birth. There was a story that he was born
while the family was visiting in Canada, but his birth was kept a secret
until the family got "home" to New England so that his records would show
an American birth. Leonard and Matilda separated, but I do not know if they
divorced. In the 1850 census for Freedom, Maine, there is a listing of a 15
year old Matilda Barlow in the household of Nathan and Mary Barlow. I do not
know if this is the Matilda I am looking for. Records in the town of Freedom
do not go back that far. Would anyone have knowledge of my g.g.grandmother,
her family, her residences and what happened to her?
