Letter and membership, 15 Jun '93, from **LORA BARLOW WRIGHT**, 3911 Black Locust Dr, Houston, TX 77088, who writes" ... told about your publication by **ELIZABETH MICHAELS**, who wrote "bunches of Barlows". .. my Barlow family goes back to Mississippi to **JOHN & LYDIA BARLOW**, who came there shortly after 1800. He was b ca 1770, NC or VA? They had sons: **WILLIAM BRYAN BARLOW**, b 1791 and **HENRY** b 1794-6 in NC. , **JOHN, NATHANIEL GREEN** and **GEORGE WASHINGTON BARLOW** They show as receiving land in the Georgia Lottery of 1807, I'm trying to find related lines. "Writer will pay for copying and postage etc"

Note: This seems to be of the lineage of **Mrs Carolyn Cole**, 320 6th Ave, La Belle FL 33935 and of **Mrs John T Watkins**, Box 23, Hammond, LA (dec'd) She wrote in 1962 that her family were from Robeson County, NC

1860 Census, Brown County, IL: No #84, JAMES BARLOW, 26, IL blacksmith, wife, MARTHA, 23 and Chn: ELIZAJ- 6 yrs and IDAE - 1 year.

Charles City County, Virginia, Wills & Deeds 1682

JOHN BARLOW & Hugh Lee Sr purchased 530 acres , Apr 1692. Hugh had taken John Barlow to court in 1687, so apparently, their difference had been settled. They sold their parcel to William PRICE in 1693. (p 244)

EARLY VIRGINIA FAMILIES ALONG THE JAMES RIVER, VOL I (HENRICO, GOOCHLAND COUNTIES)

JOSEPH ROYALL received 600 acres, 20 Aug 1642 on the river to Dockmans Creek for importing STAFFORD BARLOW, Ralph HEXON, Thomas SWIFT, Henry SMITH & wife, KATHERINE, John GUILHAM, Martha JACOBS, Nowell HURIM, Ann COLE and Thomas GUILHAM.

IBID VOL II JOHN BARLOE transported by Thomas NEWHOUSE, who received land 15 Jul 1669, (see p 40 for list of others in the group, p 40) HUGH LEE & JOHN BARLOR (Sic), received 53 acres, Jordans' Parish, 29 Apr 1692 for importing James CUTHILL, George BASS, "Xtopher" ADGAR,

Mathew ROPE (or ROYCE), Thomas GOTEN, Richard BASS, Geo PACKER, John BORROW, Robert HEATH, John CRUMP and Mary HAMSON (P 69)

Henry BATTIS & John STURDIVANT received land on s side of Appomattock for transporting 14 persons. Among them were: Eliza HAN & JOHN BARLOW, see list p 44 for other names.

Thomas THROWER & George PASSMORE took land for transporting 14 persons. Among them were JOHN BARLOW & ROBERT BARLOW, (see P 81)

Peter GILL & Henry WHITE transported 20 persons and their land was given on 15 Feb 1663, among the people was the name of SARAH BARLOW (see p 32)

One STAFFORD BARLOW was listed as being on p 85 (didn't find)

IBID VOL III, (James City County and Surry County), Capt John SMITH, land on both sides Chicohamony River, 21 Apr 1685, transported post Oct 1690, 21 Apr 1695, 12 on list including JNO BARLOE.

NOTE OBVIOUSLY JOHN BARLOW AND SOME OF THE OTHERS WERE NOT TRANSPORTED OVER AND OVER AGAIN! It was somewhat like signing a petition-I'll sign yours if you sign for me too, Some names were used without the knowledge or consent of the owner. WHAT IS important is that people are located at a time and place and a careful comparison with other names may help you to locate the place of origin in the British Isles, should any of the names be found in a definite region.

We now know that JOHN, STAFFORD, ROBERT, ELIZA, HANNAH and SARAH BARLOW were all here at an early period and were presumably family members?

All these passports were issued in the state of Georgia

10 Feb 1810- BRYANT BARLOW (See BRYAN, first page this issue) received pass to go through the Creek Nation of the Indians. (p 254)

10 Jan 1811, " ...passport for Messrs: JOHN BARLOW and BRYANT BARLOW, with seven Negroes, all of the county of

Wilkinson, GA, to travel through the Creek Nation of the Indians,(p 275)

13 Nov 1811. passport issued to travel through the Indian Nations to the Western country... one for Thomas **FRANKLIN** and one for **THOMAS BARLOW**... All from Richland County, SC (p 291)

Letter from **Susan (Lori) Stuart**, 3800 Pughsville Rd., B 77. Suffolk, VA 23435. who sends the listing of her family line:

BRAXTON BARLOW, b 8 Oct 1812, Wilkes County, NC , son of **JOHN BARLOW Jr**, d 16 Apr 1880, Wilkes County, NC. He was married 27 Jan 1834 to Charlotte **CARLTON** (b 12 Mar 1814, daughter of Thomas & Catherine Livingston Carlton). They were members of the Beaver Creek Church of Christ. Their 11 chn:

- 4) **HENRY HARRISON BARLOW** b 25 Mar, d 10 Jul 1864, soon after returning home from the Civil War, m Christmas Day, 1861, Amanda **FERGUSON**, sister of Elizabeth A. She m 2ndly, Smith F **Walker**.
- 5) **JOHN B BARLOW** , b 5 Dec 1841, d 23 Dec 1863, Richmond, VA during Civil War, un m.
- 6) **JULIA C BARLOW**, b 25 Jul 1843, m 18 Jan 1872, Roberet S **BRADLEY**
- 7) **MARTHA A BARLOW**, b 12 Jul 1845, d14 Mar 1829, m 24 Dec 1862, Rev Milton **McNIEL** (Baptist, and one time sheriff of Wilkes County, NC) . Both are buried at Mt Park Cemetery, Wilkesboro, NC
- 8) **WILLIAM FRANKLIN BARLOW** B 11 APR 1848, d 13 Jun 1921, m Martha **DULA**, 8 Oct 1871. He is buried in the Shepherd-Ferguson Cem.
- 9) **ROBERT F BARLOW**, b 17 May, 1850 (shows as un m 1880 census)
- 10) **DOCTOR PINKNEY (PICKENS) BARLOW**, b 19 MAY 1853, d 30 Sep 1874, un m
- 11) **MARY ANN BARLOW**, b 13 OCT 1857, m Frank **WILLIAMS**.

Birthdates from Bible of James Larkin Pearson, descended from Martha (Barlow) McNiel. He was Poet Laureate of NC for several years. Marriages and vitals are from Ct archives , federal census and Wilkes County documents. All chn., b in Wilkes county, NC. The writer also sent copies of various deeds relating to the Thomas L Martin Barlow and the Ferguson families of Wilkes County, NC. Interested parties may wish to write her for copies. 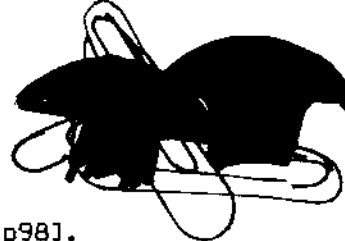
