Letter and information from new member, **Ralph F Roscoe**, 25 Mikado Drive, Colorado Springs, CO 80919:

"**Newton Wilson** of St Petersburg, FL kindly sent a copy of your February *BARLOW of BARLOW* publication. Enclosed is my check to enroll me as a member.

My interest in the name stems from my great great grandfather, **JOHN BARLOW**, who moved from Ohio to Richland County, IL in 1864. A carpenter by trade, John was a fairly prominent builder in Olney, IL until his death in 1898. Census and marriage data reveals that he was born in Ohio, m **Phebe Jane FERGUSON** there in Gurnsey County, 1847 and their first four children, including my great grandfather was born in West Virginia, probably Wheeling?, 1850-51 time frame. Records show that the parents of John were born in Maryland.

Land and census records show a **ZACHARIAH** and **MARGARET** living in Gurnsey County, OH 1814-1850 and they, too, were born in Maryland. I suspect, but cannot prove, that this couple of Londonederry Twnp, Gurnsey County, OH were parents of John Barlow. By 1860, they and other Barlows, children(?) with names as **JAMES, JOSHUA, GEORGE & ZACHARIAH JR** were located in Franklin Twnp., Monroe County, OH. The 1870 census continues to show a number of Barlows, but not the first two, perhaps during the 10 yr period?

The 1880 Census show none of the Barlows listed above, but one, **ZACHARIAH BARLOW**, son of **GEORGE BARLOW**, living in Washington County, OH. I look forward to receiving your publication and hope it will help me in my research, Are previous issues available?

Ralph, our records show that a ZACHARIAH BARLOW was living in Montgomery County, MD in 1790. A few back issues are available

STAR WILSON ROWLAND Teacher and Genealogist

Star Wilson Rowland, 89, a re-
tired teacher in the Fairfax public
school system who with her hus-
band wrote three genealogies of
their respective families, died of a
stroke March 1 at Howard County
General Hospital in Columbia.

A resident of the Vantage House
Life Care Retirement Home in Co-
lumbia since last year, she was a
former resident of Sterling and
Fairfax.

Mrs. Rowland was born in Lin-
coln, Neb. She graduated from Eu-
reka College in Eureka, Ill., and as a
young woman she was a teacher in
Illinois. She lived in Indiana, Pa.,
before moving to the Washington
area in 1944.

In the late 1940s and early
1950s, Mrs. Rowland taught at the
Weyanoke and Annandale Element-
ary schools in Fairfax County.
From 1953 to 1960, she lived in
Thailand and Turkey, where her
husband had assignments with U.S.
foreign economic programs. When
she returned here, she rejoined the
Fairfax schools and taught at West-
more Elementary until retiring in
1968.

In addition to her genealogies,
two of which received prizes from
the Maryland Historical Society,
Mrs. Rowland wrote a beginners'
text on the Turkish language called
"Practical Turkish for Americans."

Mrs. Rowland was a member of
National City Christian Church in
Washington.

Survivors include her husband of
65 years, Ralph Shearer Rowland of
Columbia; three children, Wilson
Rowland of Silver Spring, Mona
Rowland of Reston and Mary Joyce
Burks of Oakton; four sisters, Roma
Butchart of Sun City, Ariz., Violet
Lindner of Sandwich, Ill., Elaine
Miller of Deltaville, Va., and Arleen
Jacobs of Santa Monica, Calif.; five
grandchildren; and three great-
grandchildren.

BOOK REVIEWS

A NEW JERSEY BIOGRAPHICAL INDEX, by Donald Arleigh Sinclair (1980) has over 100,000 biographies with associated portraits - forty years in the making - subjects are by full name, dates of birth and death followed by code number for further research in 237 publications.

Not only biographies but genealogical sketches are covered in the index.

EARLY SETTLERS OF NEW YORK STATE by Janet Wethy Foley has new, complete, index, 425 three-column pages and lists approximately 120,000 names!

This consolidated edition from the scarce periodical, **Early Settlers from Westen New York**, then from all over the state. was in installments that ran from 1934-1942. There are many Bible records, and tombstone inscriptions, plus marriages, church records, obituaries and family lineages.

The book is divided in two volumes, 1,912 pp, Cloth, 1993, ISBN 0- 8063-1387 0 and sells for \$125.00 . Your Society should have both books.
